The 2018 AERSO Summer Circuit Shows are sanctioned as a Bronze competition member of Equestrian Canada 308 Legget Drive Suite 100, Ottawa Ontario, K2K 1Y6 and is governed by the rules of EC.(A602.1)

Per Article A801, every entry at an EC sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. (A602.7) Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location. (A602.5)

PERSON RESPONSIBLE

The Person Responsible (PR) for a horse must be an adult who has, or shares responsibility for the care, training, custody, and performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC Rules. The PR is liable under the penalty provisions of the applicable EC Rules for any rule violations.

Every entry form for an EC sanctioned competition must identify the PR and be signed by the PR.

The Person Responsible is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act performed by himself/herself or by any other person with authorized access to the horse in the stables, elsewhere on the grounds, or while the horse is being ridden, driven or exercised.

A: For adult entries into EC sanctioned competitions the PR shall be either the trainer, the owner of the horse of the competitor who rides or drives the horse during the EC sanctioned competition.

B: For Junior entries into EC sanctioned competitions the Junior competitor cannot be the PR. For Junior entries the PR may be either the trainer, the owner of the horse, or a parent/guardian of the Junior competitor.

STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLES:

Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

All Persons shall be committed to:

- upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers and competitors, or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives;
- continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions; and
- actively promoting the development and adherence of competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane. (A602.3(f))

AERSO Horse Shows are open to all horses and riders and are governed by the current rules of Equine Canada and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC rule book, available online at www.equestriancanada.ca

General Rules

All riders must be members of the Equestrian Association of the South West Region (**A.E.R.S.O.**) Membership is \$40.00 for juniors and seniors – ‘early bird’ special \$30.00 if paid before March 31st. Membership with Equestrian Canada (bronze) and Cheval Quebec is also mandatory.

ASTM approved hard hats must be worn by all riders at all times when mounted. Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise area as well as the competition ring. Hors concours is not permitted.

All entry fees and stabling charges are to be paid the day of the competition at the show secretary’s office.

Horses and/or ponies entered in all novice equitation classes over fences are permitted to go a second time in the same class with a different rider. Riders in hunter and jumper classes are permitted to ride more than one horse.

Judges are not permitted to judge any AERSO show more than twice in the same ring, in the same year.

Only the following divisions qualify to compete at the finals - Equitation - Jr A, B, C, Short Stirrup, Amateur, Pony Medal, Sandridge Medal and Jumper 3’ (.9m)

Hunter - Small, Medium, Large Ponies, Children’s and Amateur Hunters. Jumpers - .90m, 1.10m, pony

NOTE: Any horse/rider combination that has competed at the Royal Winter Fair or that has been Provincial Champion or Reserve Champion, is not permitted to compete at the Jeux Equestres Finals. More info on the rules and eligibility is available at cheval.quebec

In order to be eligible for the Jeux Equestre Finals and/or AERSO year-end awards exhibitors must compete at a minimum of 3 shows, results will only be counted for the best 5 out of 7 shows.

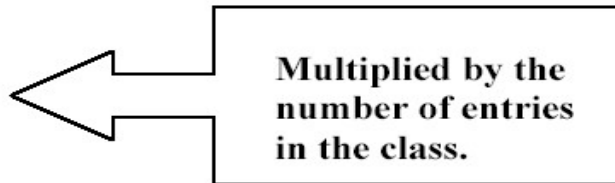
In the event of ties, most points over fences will be the deciding factor. Second tie-breaker will be decided by most first place ribbons. This will apply to all divisions.

In the jumper divisions, only the same horse/rider combination will have points counted to qualify for the Jeux Equestre Finals. If this rule is not respected, no points will be counted for this horse.

Points for year-end awards will be calculated as follows. In hunter and jumper classes, points are awarded to the horse/pony. In equitation classes, points are awarded to the rider. Flat classes have the same value. There must be a minimum of 3 entries competing for points to count. Shows may still run the class with 2.

Schedule of points as follows:

1 st . Place	-	7 points
2 nd . Place	-	5 points
3 rd . Place	-	4 points
4 th . Place	-	3 points
5 th . Place	-	2 points
6 th . Place	-	1 point



Junior ages are as follows, class heights are determined by size of their mount

Junior C is a rider who is under 12 on January 1st

Junior B is a rider who is 12 or 13 or 14 on January 1st

Junior A is a rider who is 15, 16 or 17 on January 1st

Adult/Amateur riders are over the age of 18 and defined as non-pro, as per EC rule book.

Class Rules & Specifications

Novice Equitation:

Riders may not enter any other classes and are not eligible to show as a novice for more than two years. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies.

Short Stirrup:

Open to Jr C riders who are not competing in any other division.

Training Hunter:

Open to all horse and/or pony rider combinations that have never competed over fences higher than 2'9" at Gold Horse Show. Course distances will not be adjusted for ponies. To be judged at 23' and 2'6".

Modified Junior/Amateur Classes:

Riders in these classes may not enter any classes over fences higher than the division they are showing in.

Junior C, B, A Equitation:

All horses and ponies are eligible, courses will be adjusted according to pony height.

Jr C - small pony 2'3, medium pony 2'6, large pony or horse 2'9

Jr B - small pony 2'3, medium pony 2'6, large pony or horse 2'9

Jr A - large pony 2'9, horse 3'

Children's and Amateur Hunters:

Open to all junior and non-pro riders, who are not showing in any novice or modified classes. Horses will be judged on performances, manners and way of going. Fences to 3'0".

Amateur Equitation: Open to non-pro riders who are not showing in any modified or novice classes. Fences to 3'0".

Sandridge Medal:

Open to junior and amateur riders on horses. To be judged on the rider's position, security and control on course. A minimum of 2 tests will be incorporated into the course. Fences to 3'0"

Pony Classes: All pony classes are restricted to junior riders and all ponies must have a valid measurement card.

Short Stirrup: Riders in the Short Stirrup Division are not permitted to ride in any other classes.

Sandridge Pony Medal:

To be judged under the same rules as the Sandridge Medal. Fences will be adjusted according to pony heights.

Pony Hunter:

Ponies will be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Small ponies are 12.2 hands and under.

Fences to 2'3". Medium ponies are over 12.2 and up to 13.2 hands. Fences to 2'6". Large ponies are over 13.2 and up to 14.2 hands. Fences to 2'9". Junior A riders are not permitted to ride small and medium ponies.

Jumper Classes:

Open to all horses. All riders, who are not restricted by the rules of any other class, are eligible. In the case of a clear round an immediate jump off against the clock will be held as per EC Table A rules.

Sandridge Jumper Medal: height .90m

Open to all riders who are not restricted by the rules of any other classes. To be judged on equitation. Jumping faults will not be penalized unless rider error. The top 8 riders will be called back to be judged on the flat.

Francois Ferland Jumper Medal: height 1.00m

Open to all riders who are not restricted by the rules of any other classes. To be judged on equitation with a flat phase to follow. The top two riders will qualify to attend the provincial finals at the Concours Hippique de Levis in Breakeyville, QC in Sept.

JOGGING FOR SOUNDNESS: CLASSES IN THE FOLLOWING DIVISIONS WILL BE ASKED TO JOG FOR SOUNDNESS BEFORE PRESENTATION OF THE RIBBONS – AMATEUR HUNTERS, CHILDRENS HUNTERS AND SMALL, MEDIUM AND LARGE PONIES.
