INT. CONFERENCE ROOM - SAME

Mid-interview. Jack sits across from Mark.

JACK

INT. RICHARDS RESIDENCE - LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

SC.2

Jack, Trent, Beth and Janice wait for Mark. Mark enters.
They cool it.

START →

MARK

She doesn't want to talk right now.
She's kind of freaking out. I
think we have to move.

BETH

Don't worry about that.

MARK

I want talk to Chad. Maybe if we
hash it out ourselves.

JACK

Nothing good comes from that
meeting, Mark.

Mark suddenly explodes.

MARK

He went after my wife and kid! I
can't just sit here!

Everyone's a bit startled.

BETH

Mark, a lot of victims of stalking
often find themselves in a
traumatic cycle where they begin to
anticipate the next stalking event.
The experience is not unlike PTSD
and it can lead to irrational acts.

MARK

I'm not irrational.

BETH

I wasn't saying that.

CONTINUED:

MARK

I just don't like sitting around
doing nothing.

Beth meets Mark's angry gaze.

BETH

There is something you can do.
The LAPD is investigating Chad, but
there's still a lot they don't know
about him, his group and how they
operate. You could help put Chad
away for a very long time.

MARK

You want me to become a rat.
I do that and I'm marked for life.
Not just by Chad, but by every
other skinhead out there.

BETH

You created this problem. And now
he's just out there. You can do
something about that.

MARK

You think I deserve this.

BETH

No one thinks that.

MARK

I think it's time you all leave.
