

**TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH LONDONDERRY
LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

RESOLUTION 2014-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH LONDONDERRY, LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA OPPOSING THE PROPOSED ATLANTIC SUNRISE PROJECT PIPELINE AND REQUESTING THAT THE FEDERAL ENERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION DISAPPROVE THE LOCATION OF ANY PORTION OF THE PIPELINE WITHIN THIS TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, The Williams Companies, Inc. plans to construct a 178 mile, 42-inch diameter pipeline from Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania to Lancaster County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Pipeline is planned to transport approximately 1,700,000 dekatherms of natural gas per day; and

WHEREAS, the Pipeline is planned to be operational in the second half of 2017; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2014, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued a Notice of Intent to Prepare an Environmental Impact Statement for the Atlantic Sunrise Project under the National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA") pre-filing process; and

WHEREAS, Williams Companies, Inc. intends to file a formal application with FERC in the Spring of 2015; and

WHEREAS, the pre-filing process and the formal application process both provide opportunities for public input and intervention; and

WHEREAS, the South Londonderry Township is concerned that the Pipeline Project will have a negative effect on South Londonderry Township's property values; South Londonderry Township's environment; and the public health, safety and welfare of South Londonderry Township residents; and

WHEREAS, the Pipeline Project is planned to cross lands in South Londonderry Township that are environmentally sensitive; lands that are preserved by the expenditure of public funds for the exclusive use of agriculture; and lands that are preserved by the expenditure of public funds for the use, enjoyment and permanent protection of open space; and

WHEREAS, the Pipeline Project will cause irreparable damage to these properties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of South Londonderry, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, that the Township

administration is empowered to participate and intervene in the regulatory process as necessary to protect the interests of the Township and its residents to oppose the construction of the Atlantic Sunrise Project Pipeline within the Township. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.


