## OUR WORK

The mission of the Old-Growth Forest Network (OGFN) is to connect people with nature by creating a national network of protected, mature, and publicly-accessible native forests.

The Old-Growth Forest Network is a 501(c)(3) organization that was founded because the old-growth forests that were this nation's inheritance have been mostly removed or radically altered (average loss is 95% in the west, 99% in the east). We work to preserve our last remaining old-growth forests and connect the people that care about them through our nationwide Network. We do this by identifying at least one forest that will be forever-protected from logging and open to the public, in each U.S. county that has native forest habitat.

The result is growing into a national Network of treasured forests where all generations can experience native biodiversity.
