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
2016 Republican Primary Election Voting Analysis April 13, 2016

The following report is an analysis of who voted in the 2016 Republican Primary Election. It is based on information provided by the Texas Secretary of State and voter data compiled by Ryan Data & Research.

Turnout


The 2016 primary election set a new record for turnout for the Republican Party. According to the Secretary of State, over 2.8 million people cast a vote (19.9% of registered voters). In comparison, turnout in the 2012 Republican Primary was only 1.4 million (11.1%). Only 38,499 votes kept the 2016 Republican Primary from surpassing the total number of votes cast in the 2008 Democratic Primary election.

- A Republican Primary election was held in every county in the state.
- Borden County had the highest turnout with 70.3%, while Starr County had the lowest turnout with 0.4%.
- Harris County had the most voters with 327,046, while Kenedy County had the fewest with 19.
- Turnout in the top 15 counties averaged 20.9%.



Under Votes


According to the Secretary of State's numbers, 2,836,488 people voted for a presidential candidate in the primary. However, only 2,068,106 people voted for the next statewide race on the ballot (Railroad Commissioner). This was an under vote rate of 27.1%



- King County had the largest under vote percentage with 50.4% (115 people voted for president and only 57 voted for railroad commissioner).
- Jim Hogg County had the smallest under vote percentage with only 7.1% (42 people voted for president and only 3 did not vote for railroad commissioner).
- The under vote percentage averaged 28.1% for the top 15 counties. Collin County had the largest drop (38.6%) with Travis County close behind (35.9%).

Voters – By Age

The Republican Party continues to have an age issue when it comes to voters who participate in the primary election process. The average age of voters was 57 years old and only one-third of the voters were under the age of 50.




Voters – By Gender

Despite the narrative that the Republican Party is waging a “war on women,” the numbers don’t seem to indicate that women are fleeing the party. Of all voters who voted in the 2016 Republican Primary...

- 49.0% were women
- 46.4% were men
- 4.6% did not have a gender identified on the Secretary of State’s voter list

Voters – By Previous Election History

With record turnout numbers, the discussion has been about how many first time Republican voters actually showed up for the 2016 primary. Based on past election history in Ryan Data & Research’s voter database, over 1.1 million people who cast a vote in the 2016 Republican Primary had not voted in a previous Republican Primary between 2008 and 2014. Below, is each group’s portion of the 2016 Republican Primary vote.



Voters with past GOP Primary history, but no previous DEM Primary history: 48.5%

Voters who have voted in both party’s primaries, but most recently voted in a GOP Primary: 9.8%

Voters with past DEM Primary history, but no previous GOP Primary history: 7.0%

Voters who have voted in both party’s primaries, but most recently voted in a DEM Primary: 0.7%

Voters with no Primary Election history (R or D), but have voted in a General Election: 25.9%

Voters with no Primary Election history (R or D) or General Election history: 8.1%

The share of voters with previous Republican Primary history could have been significantly higher, but nearly one million voters with previous Republican Primary history stayed home this year. These people showed up to vote at least once when John McCain, Mitt Romney, Ted Cruz, Rick Perry, John Cornyn, and Greg Abbott were at the top of the ballot, but decided not to vote in this primary.


Based on Republican Primary election history from 2008 to 2014...

- 87.6% of the voters who voted in all four of these primaries turned out to vote in 2016.
- 79.4% of the voters who voted in three of these primaries turned out to vote in 2016.
- 67.4% of the voters who voted in two of these primaries turned out to vote in 2016.
- **Only 46.5% of the voters who voted in one of these primaries turned out to vote in 2016.**


Voters – By Voting Method

Of the votes cast on Election Day, 50.9% had no previous Republican Primary history. During early voting (and votes cast by mail), these voters only made up 28.8% of all early votes cast. The chart below shows each group's portion of the Election Day vote versus their portion of the early/mail vote.

Turnout Based on Past Election History (Top 15 Counties)

(Example: In Harris County, 48.4% of the people who voted in the 2016 Republican Primary are previous Republican Primary voters with no past Democratic Primary history.)
