Guidelines:

1. Entry Fee: \$10.00 per entry
2. California cattle of all breeds must be from a herd that is not affected with Tuberculosis or Brucellosis. Females 24 months of age or older on opening day of the fair must have a calf at side or show obvious signs of pregnancy.
3. Exhibitor must be the bonafide owners of cattle and registration papers must show them as such not less than 30 days prior to fair. Bill of sale or birth records showing exhibitor-bred heifer must verify ownership rule for commercial females.
4. Cow/Calf qualifications: The cow and calf must be shown as individuals in their respective age class.

BEEF REPLACEMENT HEIFER

1. Entries are limited to 4-H, and FFA members and qualified independent junior exhibitors of San Bernardino County.
2. Registered or grade beef replacement heifers are eligible projects. Heifers must be without horns.
3. The age limit is a minimum of 6 months old with a maximum age being 15 months old on opening day of the fair.
4. All heifers must bear evidence of having the official calf-hood brucellosis vaccination with the presence of any official tattoo visible in the right ear.
5. The project member must have had ownership of the heifer by Jan 20, 2018. A bill of sale and/or brand inspection certificate is required as proof of ownership.
6. If an exhibitor declares that the heifer is registered, the registration papers must be signed off and submitted to the livestock office before the heifer will be allowed to sell.
7. Grand and Reserve Champion Beef Replacement Heifers are required to sell at auction.
8. The beef replacement heifer can sell in lieu of a market animal.
9. Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to market their heifers to potential buyers prior to the Junior Livestock Auction via personal contact, written correspondence, posters, etc. Each exhibitor should create a display board with all pertinent information regarding their heifer project to be posted at their beef exhibit during the fair.
10. All beef replacement heifers will be weighed on the fair scales during beef weigh-ins. Heifers will show by weight.
11. When entered in this division the animal may not be entered or shown in any other division.
12. Female must be inspected by fair appointed person for reproductive viability.

SBCF Dairy Replacement Heifer Program

1. **Entry Fee: \$10 per entry**
2. Must be a breed suitable for commercial dairy milking purposes (i.e.: Holstein, Jersey, or crossbreds)
3. Must be owned by the exhibitor for a minimum of 90 days prior to the opening day of the fair in which the heifer is shown as a yearling. Proof of ownership will be a bill of sale or a signed statement and project book showing the animal was dropped from the exhibitor's cow and raised by the exhibitor.
4. All cattle must be de-horned, from a herd that is not infected with tuberculosis, and bear evidence of official calthood vaccination against brucellosis.
5. To be eligible to sell your heifer at the San Bernardino County Fair Auction you *must* show your heifer at the San Bernardino County Fair for 2 years – 1st year as a yearling and 2nd year as a bred heifer. It is preferred that the heifer is due to freshen at or around fair time.
6. Sale heifers must have proof of pregnancy age as verified by a licensed veterinarian or fair management designee.
7. Exhibitors may only sell 1 heifer per year in the San Bernardino County Fair Auction.
8. In the event that the heifer freshens during the fair and before the auction, the heifer and calf will be sold as a pair.

Guidelines:

1. Entry Fee: \$10.00 per Entry per Class
2. Sow, Junior Yearling or older must have raised a litter of pigs or show obvious signs of farrowing to be eligible for entry.
3. All swine must originate in validated Brucellosis and Pseudorabies free herd or areas California is a validated state. Out of state swine must be accompanied by an official health certificate confirming validated status of the herd or area of origin.
4. Gilts entered in the market hog division may not be entered in the breeding division or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the Fair.
5. Management reserves the right to combine &/or split divisions for the good of the show. Divisions may change after entries close.
6. All boars must be detusked!
7. All boars born prior to December 31, 2017 must be checked for tusks prior to being unloaded.
8. An adult must accompany every boar born prior to December 31, 2017 with a hog board at all times, including the show arena.
9. All ear notches must be readable and healed upon arrival.

Show Guidelines:

1. Entry Fee: **\$10.00 per Entry per Class**
2. **Rules:** The ABGA Rules, California Div of Fairs & Expositions State Rules and the local rules of the San Bernardino County Fair will govern the show.
3. **Age of Animals:** Birth dates on the registration certificate will be used to determine class entries.
4. **Females:** Any female over 24 months of age that has not kidded and cannot prove current pregnancy will not be allowed to show.
5. **Registration:** All goats must be registered in the herd book of a recognized association. Recognized associations include the American Boer Goat Association, the International Boer Goat Association, the IBGA and the Canadian Boer Goat Association. The original registration certificate is required. The registration certificate and this show's entry form must be in the owner's name. Information on transfers is not acceptable.
6. **Breeding:** All animals must be registered purebred or percentage blood Boer goats and the registration papers and tattoo(s) or other means of permanent identification that matches the one(s) on its registration certificate or the animal will not be shown. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent identification, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader. Tattoo policy will be strictly enforced..
