

Open & Youth Pygmy Goat Show

All livestock entries are due on-line: April 20, 2018 by 12:00 am midnight

1. ENTRY FEE \$7.00
2. NPGA Sanctioned, NPGA Rules to Govern
3. The Youth and Open shows are separately sanctioned.
4. Registration papers are required and must be checked in by the entry clerk, prior to the animal's breed being shown.
5. All goats entering fairs require individual identification. All official identification will be kept on animals. See State Rules for Sheep and Goat health certificates.
6. We will eliminate any animal from the grounds showing signs of contagious disease; this includes runny eyes or noses, abscesses not completely healed or skin infections.
7. The San Bernardino County Fair & the above listed Pygmy Goat Clubs are not responsible for damages or injury to any person, animals or property of exhibitors.
8. Youth exhibitors who are also showing in the sanctioned Youth show, with additional entry fees, may show in the open show.
9. By entering and signing your entry form, you agree to comply with these rules. The rules will be enforced.
10. The open show begins following the youth senior doe show.
11. Champion and reserve rosettes are awarded. No premium monies will be paid in the open or youth Pygmy Goat Show(s).
12. All pens must be cleaned or arrangements must be made in the livestock office prior to any releases being written.
13. **No more than two (2) substitutions per exhibitor.**
