Wood Carving Guidelines

- ◆ All previously noted General Information, Local Rules, and State Rules apply to this section.
- ◆ Entry Fees: \$2.00 per entry, per class.
- ◆ Each piece entered must be the work of only the person entering the piece and must have been completed since May 2017. Carvings must be dated.
- ◆ Each carving must be made entirely from wood: exceptions are glass eyes; wire/metal is okay where needed for mounting strength, whiskers and barbells. No machine blanks accepted.
- ◆ All entries must be fully assembled at time of entry.
- ◆ Department chairperson reserves the right to change division &/or class &/or disqualify entries when necessary.
- ◆ All entries must be packaged for protection during the time period between judging and fair display. Packages should be tied with string rather than being taped together. Exterior of package should be labeled with exhibitor's name and number of pieces in package.

- ◆ No loose packing materials such as peanuts, popcorn, loose granular materials, etc. Any entry not properly packaged may be refused.
- ◆ Definitions:
 - Novice** - Carvers who have not won 2 blue ribbons on 2 different woodcarvings.
 - Advanced** - Carvers who have not won 10 blue ribbons on 5 different woodcarvings.
 - Expert** - Carvers who are not eligible for Advanced or Novice class.
 - Professional** - Anyone who carves or teaches woodcarving as a business or profession rather than a hobby or pastime.
- ◆ **NOTE:** A carver may voluntarily advance to the next class of carvers, but once you advance you may not return to the previous class.
- ◆ **Letters:** Please use to describe finish on piece.
- ◆ Please note on your entry form with your entry description, the type of finish on your item.
- ◆ **Premiums offered per class of this Department:**
1st place \$3.00, 2nd place \$2.00 and 3rd place \$1.00
