

Blue Team Spring Recap

- Batiquitos Lagoon Resiliency Project: Blue Team is participating in the development of a resiliency plan to support management of the Batiquitos Lagoon in a changing climate. The proposed plan would be created as a joint effort of by the City of Carlsbad, the Tijuana River National Estuarine Research Reserve, the Batiquitos Lagoon Foundation, the CA Department of Fish and Wildlife, and the Climate Science Alliance-South Coast.
- Resilient Restoration Project: Climate Science Alliance partners developed a list of 30 regional research needs ranging from climate change disaster forecasting to control of invasive under new climate norms. We are addressing one of the research needs by evaluating vulnerability and resiliency of upland plant species.
- Living Shorelines Project: We are compiling examples of relevant living shoreline methods and approaches for Southern California and hosting workshops in 2017 to expand knowledge and expertise for using natural methods of shoreline stabilization to protect coastal communities and infrastructure.
