SCALING UP IMPLEMENTATION FOR ACCESSING REDD+ PAYMENTS

This high-level joint UN-REDD Programme and World Bank Group side event will feature a town-hall style dialogue to highlight how REDD+ and other forest-focused land-use initiatives have been instrumental in triggering change at country level.

The objective of the event is to explore different potential finance streams for countries, spanning from

bilateral (REM) and multilateral support (through the BioCarbon Fund, GEF and GCF) to the private sector.

This side event will also present experiences of countries in different stages to enable them to learn from each other and leapfrog toward implementation and results based payments.
