

# Lexington Home & School Club Explained

The Lexington Home & School Club (HSC) is a parent-teacher organization that provides fundraising and volunteer efforts to support programs and activities directly benefitting your children. HSC is the thread that connects the culture and spirit of our school, linking home and community with the school's educational mission. HSC also works closely with the Los Gatos Educational Foundation (LGEF) to coordinate district-wide fundraising for programs that benefit students at Lexington.

The Lexington Home & School Club funds the following staff, resources and programs that would not be available without parent support. Lex HSC needs to raise **\$94,590** in 2017-18, or **\$630 per student**, through our Membership Donation Drive and other fundraising efforts throughout the year. Here is the detailed per-child breakdown of how your contributions will support our children this year.
