

2017 SAT and AP Results

Research shows that students meeting the **SAT College & Career Readiness Benchmark score of <u>1010</u>** have a higher likelihood of being successful in subject-related first-semester college courses. While college readiness and success are dependent upon many factors, this reinforces the importance of an academically rigorous high school program.

Bishop Stang High School National Merit Scholars

In 2017, approximately 50,000 of the 1.6 million entrants nationwide were recognized for having the highest PSAT/NMSQT® scores through the National Merit Scholarship Program.

- ❖ 1 National Merit Hispanic Scholar Recognition for Hispanic/Latino students who achieve the minimum required PSAT/NMSQT Selection Index score and earn a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher by the middle of their junior year.
- ❖ <u>4 National Merit Scholar Commended Students</u> About 2/3 of the 50,000 high scorers receive Letters of Commendation in recognition of their outstanding academic promise.
