# MOOSE HUNT

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Info:

This crochet square pattern is a part of a Finnish crochet project. We have designed a crochet blanket based on the Kalevala Mythology. It has been created as a tribute to Finland's 100 years of independence. KALEVALA-CAL: Moose Hunt

Ch = chain

ch-sp = chain space

dc = double crochet

tr = treble crochet

R = round/row

sk = skip

st = stitch



This square is started from corner and will be crocheted by two sides as one round expect the last round which goes around the whole square.

Make slip knot and crochet ch 5

R1: tr to beginning st, ch 2, dc to the same st. Turn the work

R2: ch 3 (counts as dc), 1 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp. Turn the work

R3: ch 3 (counts as dc), 1 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 2dc. Turn the work

R4: ch 3 (counts as dc), 3 dc, 2dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, dc 4. Turn the work

R5: ch 3 ( counts as dc), 1 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 2 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 6 dc. Turn the work

R6: 3 ch (counts as dc), 7 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, dc 8  
(the 8 dc: 4 of these dcs to dcs, 2 into ch-sp, 2 dc to dcs. From now on always crochet 2 dc into ch-sp of ski pole ring´s marks)

R7: ch 3 (counts as dc), 9 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 2dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 6 dc. Turn the work

R8: ch 3 (counts as dc), 11 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 12 dc. Turn the work

R9: ch 3 (counts as dc), 9 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 2 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 14 dc. Turn the work

R10: ch 3 (counts as dc), 15 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 16 dc. Turn the work

R11: ch 3 (counts as dc), 17 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 2 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 14 dc. Turn the work

R12: ch 3 (counts as dc), 19 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 20 dc. Turn the work

R13: ch 3 (counts as dc), 3 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 2 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 8 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 2 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 12 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 2 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc 4. Turn the work

R14: ch 3 (counts as dc), 23 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 24 dc. Turn the work

R15: ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc, ch 3, sk 3 dc, 2 dc, ch 3, sk 3 dc, 15 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 2 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 11 dc, ch 3, sk 3 dc, 2 dc, ch 3, sk 3 dc, 3 dc. Turn the work

R16: ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc, ch 3, sk 3 ch, 2 dc, ch 3, sk 3 ch-st, 17 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 17 dc, ch 3, sk 3 ch, 2 dc, ch 3, sk 3 ch, 3 dc. Turn the work

R17: ch 3 (counts as dc), 1 dc, 2 dc into next dc, ch 2, sk 3 ch, 2 dc, ch 2, sk 3 ch, 2 dc into next dc, 14 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 2 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 18 dc, 2 dc into next dc, ch 2, sk 3 ch, 2 dc, ch 2, sk 2 ch, 2 dc into next dc, 2 dc. Turn the work

R18: ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc, 2 dc into next dc, ch 1, sk 2 ch, 2 dc, ch 1, sk 2 ch, 2 dc into next dc, 21 dc, 2 dc into ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 21 dc, 2 dc into next dc, ch 1, sk 2 ch, 2 dc, ch 1, sk 2 ch, 2 dc into next dc, 2 dc. Turn the work

R19: ch 3 (counts as dc), 33 dc, 2 dc into corner ch-sp, ch 2, tr into tr, ch 2, 2 dc into ch-sp, 2 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 30 dc. Turn the work

R20 will be crocheted around the whole square: ch 3 (counts as dc), 37 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) into tr, 37 dc (side), (dc, ch 3, dc) into the corner st, 37 dc (side), (dc, ch 3, dc) into the corner st, 37 dc (side), (dc, ch 3) into same st as the beginning, join with sl st into 3rd ch-st.

There are 39dc + 3 ch on each side

Fasten off and secure ends. Finish like you wish.



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
