

Why Certification Matters

“Certification is about establishing oneself as a professional in the eyes of the other professionals you work with. It adds credibility and esteem to what ALL of us do. Certification benefits the entire profession: When we achieve and maintain certification, we protect the health of our profession by:

1. Demonstrating that we practice within an evidence-based scope of practice that limits the doula to support practices that truly benefit families. *Doulas who don't practice within a defined, evidence-based scope are at an increased risk of practicing in ways that harm families and the profession.*
2. Achieving greater visibility, bargaining and political leverage to be included as legitimate members of the maternity care team. *No one can do that as an individual. It must be done collectively through strong, member-supported certification organizations and associations.*
3. Increasing consumer and health care provider trust that our specialized skills are achieved through high standards for training and vetted through certification.
