The past summer and fall was busy for the Prescott church.

We continued to hold Monday Night Movie outreaches in the park and Friday night concerts throughout the summer, with impact being made in our city.

We have also been trying new outreaches to reach the community.

Pastor Diego Galvan, our Spanish Pastor, has been being seeing breakthrough in our Spanish-speaking community. He was recently able to preach a Spanish healing crusade in Chino Valley. It was a fruitful time, and we saw several divine appointments.

One of those was a young man who was riding his motorcycle past the park, and felt the urge to stop but didn't know why. So he stopped and came over and stayed through the crusade. That man gave his life to Christ, and was also healed from back pain and a leg which was one and a half inches short! At the end of the night there were three decisions made for God!

This year we tried something new and held a Veterans Day outreach. Pete Walter headed it up, putting on a breakfast in the morning for all Veterans and then a show in the afternoon following the Veterans Day parade.

During the show we had booths set up with pictures, memorabilia and weapons from different wars. We had a group of women who sang and did a tribute to the "Andrews Sisters," and we had a BBQ lunch to go along with it.

Throughout the day we had more than 300 people come through and stay for the food, music and testimonies. There were many personal contacts made, and more than 20 people gave their lives to Christ!

One lady in our church, Ronnalyn DeBlois, prayed with an elderly veteran for salvation. When they were finished the gentleman told her that

he had always been afraid to die, but now he wasn't afraid anymore! It was an exciting new outreach for us, and we look forward to trying it again next year!

We put on our annual Haunted House this year, with more than 109 people involved, from actors, to costumers, to make up artists, the sound and light crews, the altar call preachers and the witnessing room workers. We had a great turnout this year, partly due to the fact that we were the only Haunted House in Prescott.

We had hundreds come through in groups of 20 or so, and we had whole groups raise their hands and pray in the altar call. When it was all finished there were 122 total decisions for Christ.

We did a follow up outreach the weekend after, and several people came out, including whole families who gave their lives to Christ!

In October we had the privilege of having Pastor Martin Klok, from Holland, preach a revival for us. He started on Saturday Morning ministering to the youth in our annual Youth extreme. He preached on the anointing of God before sending them out to evangelize on the streets! There was great impact made in the city through one-on-one evangelism. We were also excited to have the opportunity to Street preach on a corner downtown, across from a local festival going on. Many young people stood up and proclaimed what Jesus had done for them for the very first time! The day was wrapped up with a special concert, and at the end of the day there were 34 decisions for Christ.

Pastor Klok continued ministering throughout the week, and God was faithful to meet with us every night. It was an encouraging and strengthening time for the church as Pastor Klok ministered with a word of knowledge and spoke into the lives of many in the congregation. The revival has finished but as a congregation we are revived, refreshed and excited as we push ahead into a new season of outreach.

Hello from The Potter's House in Rochester, New York! We are so grateful for everyone who is praying for us, as we are praying for all of you!

We ended the summer with a launching service for our church

plant into Greece, New York and we're excited to see what God is doing there! Already there are seven people attending regularly, and many souls have been saved on regular outreaches.

In September we performed our Super Fairy Tale musical again to a full house, with dozens of visitors hearing the clear gospel message and many responding to the call for salvation.
