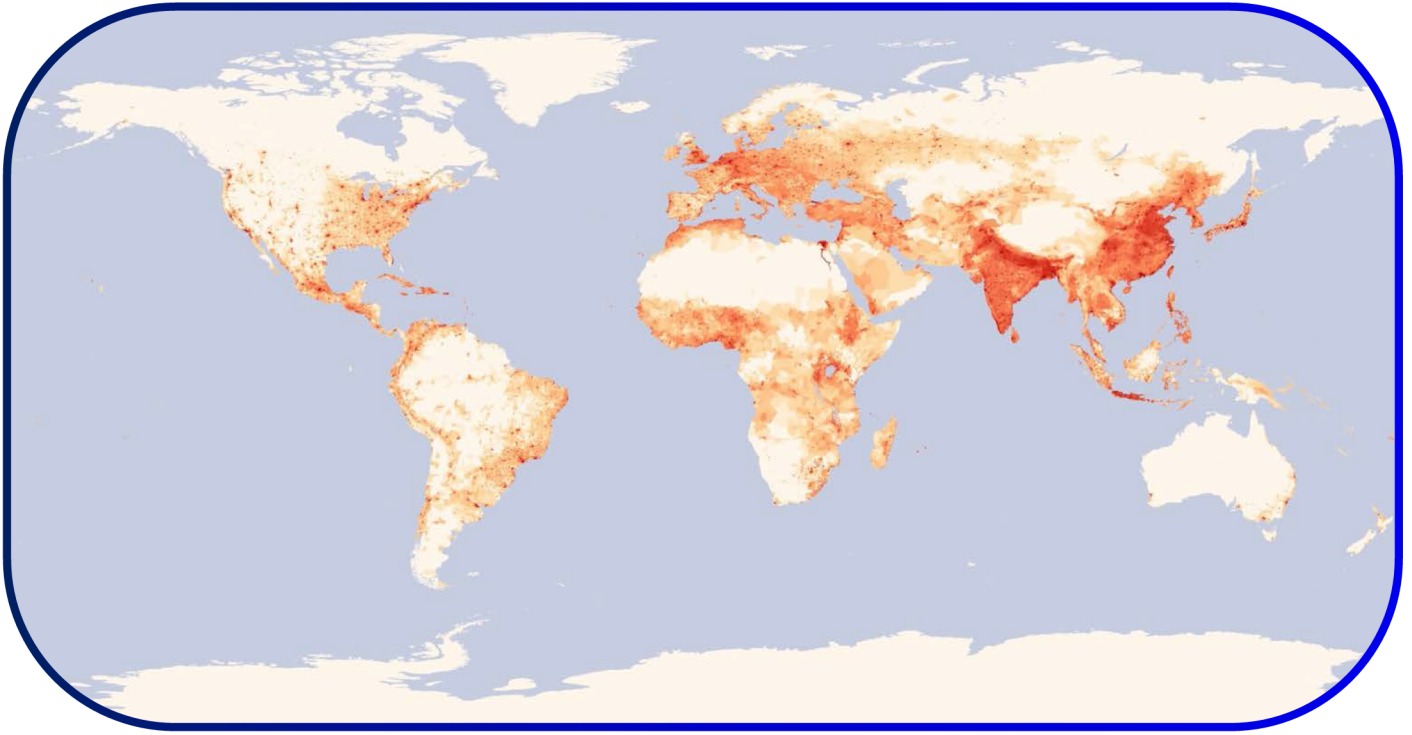


Population density

This is a **population density map of the world**. Areas that are deep red in colour are densely populated. Areas that are white in colour are sparsely populated.
