Council announces new logo winner

Ray Kurniawan was announced as the winner of the Bayside Council logo competition at the Council meeting on Wednesday 9 September.

Administrator Greg Wright presented Ray, who also won the People's Choice Award, with a certificate and a cheque for \$2000.

"The selection of the logo to represent Bayside Council into the future was a difficult one. Not only does the design have to reflect the vision of Bayside it needs to work graphically on all Council's signage. I think we all agree the new logo represents everything Council stands for and I would like to congratulate Ray Kurniawan," Greg Wright said.

Ray, a Mascot resident, works as a business analysis with the NSW Police Force and dabbles in design as a hobby.

"The idea to use the boat came from the idea that to move forward in a boat everyone has to row together. Bayside is a new community and to move forward everyone needs to work together," said Ray.

Bayside Council received 78 logo designs from 40 individuals in the recent competition to find a new logo which reflects the new Council.

Over 1900 people voted in the People's Choice Award.

Farady Richmond won the Junior Award for a beautifully hand drawn logo of a sunset over Botany Bay. Helen Wang, a first year design student, won the Youth Award.

Council will now begin rolling out the new logo design.

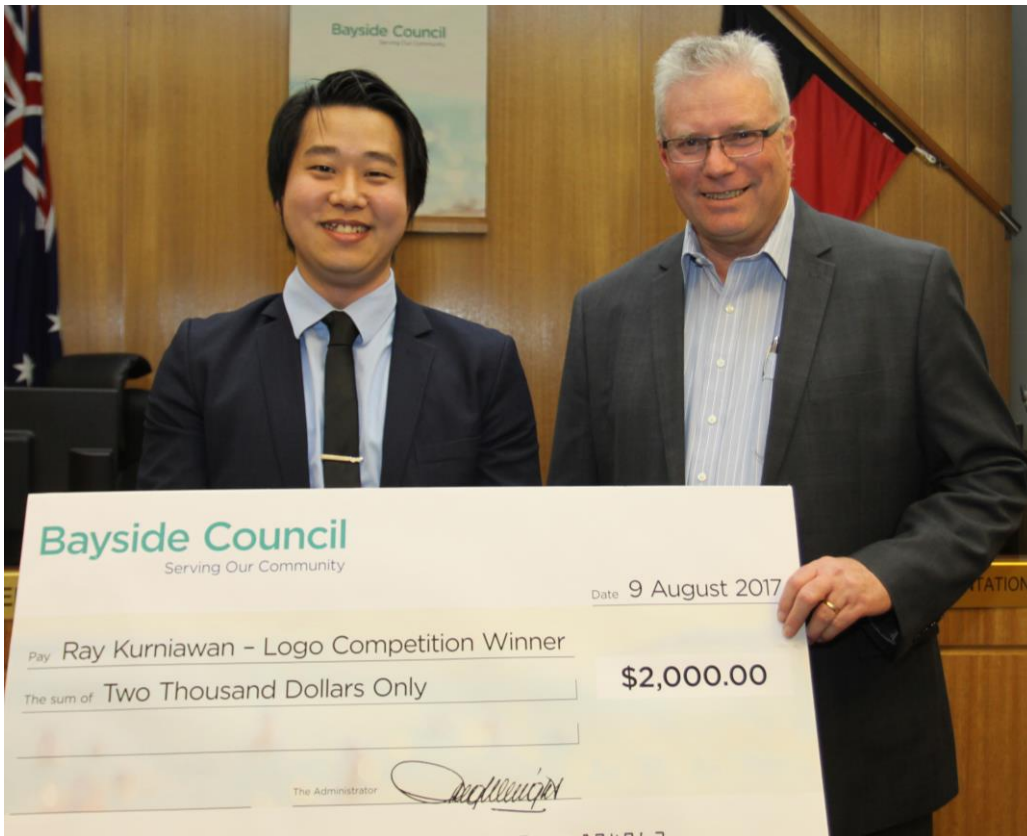
