

The ultimate wine-by-the-glass at Larkin's On The River / [@EatDrinkCarolinas](#)



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What does a \$112 glass (yes, not bottle) of wine taste like? You can find out at Larkin's, but we did the taste test for you. 😊

This cabernet doesn't see the light of day on a typical by-the-glass list (the bottle price is \$450), but if you believe the adage *good things come in small packages*, then a little of this vino may be worth the experience.

Say hello to the **Shafer "Hillside Select" Cabernet Sauvignon, often a 100 point rated wine**. It is heady on the nose, complex on the palate with a subtle red fruit finish.

Larkin's Certified Specialist of Wine, Bruce Wise, says they pour it because he wants more people to have the opportunity to taste one of today's iconic wines.

Glass pours are possible using a Coravin, a device that pierces the cork to dispense wine without causing oxidation.

And, if you're game for a three-ounce pour you can taste it for just \$56.
