The Bishop's Challenge is meant to move all NJ Synod congregations to grow in awareness, generosity, service and advocacy in response to hunger. Below is a calendar of ideas for each month between now and the next synod assembly. Worship ideas, prayers, preaching possibilities, and educational materials specifically designed for the year ahead will be posted periodically on the synod website (www.njsynod.org "Bishop's Challenge").

May:

Plan your year of ELCA Hunger Awareness and Giving! Set a challenge goal for your congregation, and form an Action Team to keep you moving. Send in your commitment card.

July:

Get involved in Summer Feeding programs in your community, connect your serving to a Bible study that focuses on the Biblical imagery of "Bread of Life". What about a sermon series?

June:

Plant an extra row in your garden and commit the abundance to a local food pantry. Consider incorporating ideas from ELCA World Hunger free VBS curriculum "God's Good Gifts" in your VBS.

August:

September:

Organize Backpack Buddies for kids in your community that experience food insecurity. Does your school serve Breakfast After the Bell? How can you help the Community College near you address hunger among college students?

November:

Thanksgiving is a perfect time to focus in worship and prayer on gratitude for all of God's gifts. How will your congregation share generously with ELCA World Hunger?

October:

Celebrate World Food Day on Oct. 16th by hosting an international pot luck in your community. Encourage participants to share their ethnic food traditions.

December:

The Advent season embraces a call to compassion and justice. How are you preparing for Emmanuel? ELCA Good Gifts is an opportunity to give a gift of hope and opportunity.


