FICTION LITERARY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is effective as of 16 June 1986 and is between: NORMAN F. STARKEY, as Executor of the Estate of L. Ron Hubbard, whose address is 6515 Sunset Blvd., Suite 202, Hollywood, California, 90028 as successor in interest to L. Ron Hubbard, deceased

(hereafter referred to as "Proprietor")

and

Bridge Publications Inc, 1414 N. Catalina Street, Los Angeles, California, 90029.

(hereafter referred to as "Publisher")

regarding the ten books of "MISSION EARTH" entitled:

VOLUME I. THE INVADERS PLAN

VOLUME II. BLACK GENESIS, FORTRESS OF EVIL

VOLUME III. THE ENEMY WITHIN

VOLUME IV. AN ALIEN AFFAIR

VOLUME V. FORTUNE OF FEAR

VOLUME VI. DEATH QUEST

VOLUME VII. VOYAGE OF VENGEANCE

VOLUME VIII. DISASTER

VOLUME IX. VILLAINY VICTORIOUS

VOLUME X. THE DOOMED PLANET

(hereafter referred to as the "Work".)

THE PARTIES AGREE as follows:

1. GRANT OF RIGHTS:

Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, Proprietor hereby grants Publisher for a term of seven (7) years (from the date hereof) the exclusive right to "publish" (i.e., print, publish and sell) the Work in hardbound and paperback form in the following countries and languages:

Countries: United States and Canada

Language: English

2 PROPRIETOR APPROVAL OF ABRIDGED VERSIONS:

Publisher shall not publish any condensed or abridged versions, selections, condensations or abridgements in anthologies, textbook editions, book digests or in newspapers or magazines, except as provided in this Agreement.

3. PUBLISHER'S WARRANTY:

The Publisher shall, unless prevented by war, strikes, lockouts or other circumstances beyond its control:

- A) Use its best efforts to produce, publish and distribute within the Countries:
- i) The Work as a 10 volume hardcover series with the first volume of said series to be released by 30 November 1985 with subsequent volumes to be released over a period not to exceed three (3) years.
- ii) The Work as a 10 volume paperback series which such series shall be released over a period not to exceed three (3) years.
- It is further agreed that, not withstanding paragraph 14D, all rights in and to the Work shall forthwith revert whole and unencumbered to Proprietor automatically in the event that such timely publication of each volume does not occur; and that Proprietor shall be entitled to retain any monies paid pursuant to paragraph 9F in the event of such reversion.
- B) Use its best efforts to sell and promote the sale of copies of the Work and in connection therewith Publisher agrees to spend on advertising, promotion and publicity for each volume of the Work, whether, hardcover or paperback, the minimum sum equivalent to five (5) % of the retail price of each copy printed within six (6) months of each printing.

Publisher acknowledges that the Work is a 10 volume sequel and will be released as ten separate books. Publisher further agrees to undertake in all promotion and advertising to refer to the Work as MISSION EARTH plus its volume name.

4 CHANGES IN THE WORK:

No one except Proprietor may make any change in the Work or titles. Advertising or other materials may not be inserted or printed in the Work without Proprietor's prior written consent and such consent may be withheld in Proprietor's sole discretion. The preceding sentence shall not apply to advertising by Publisher which promotes the sale by Publisher of the Work.

5. PROPRIETOR'S WARRANTIES AND INDEMNITY:

- A) Proprietor represents and warrants that:
- i) He is the sole owner of the Work, which Work is an original literary work by L. Ron Hubbard and he now now owns and controls all rights granted hereunder free of liens or encumbrances, and has full power to execute this Agreement;
- ii) The Work does not, to the best of Proprietor's knowledge, infringe statutory copyrights or common law literary rights of others and to the best of his knowledge, does not violate the right of privacy of, or libel, other persons.
- B) Proprietor agrees to indemnify and hold the Publisher harmless from any final judgment for damages against it (after all appeals have been taken) in any action arising out of facts which constitute a breach of the foregoing warranties and against reasonable costs and attorneys' fees incurred by it in defending an action in which such judgement is recovered. It is understood and agreed, however, that this indemnity does not apply to any material in the Work which Publisher could have determined, from a reading of the Work, violated any rights specified in subparagraph A(ii) above.
- C. Publisher shall give Proprietor prompt notice of any lawsuit or claim alleging facts which would constitute a breach of the warranties in subparagraph A. Proprietor, if he chooses, may defend such suit with counsel of his own choosing and at his own expense; provided that if he does, Publisher may participate in the defense with counsel of its choosing (and at its own expense subparagraph B not withstanding).

6) PUBLISHING FORMAT:

The format, style and composition of the text, graphic material and captions of each volume of each edition of the Work, including cover and dust jacket, shall be determined by Publisher subject to Proprietor's written approval which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

7. ADVERTISING:

Proprietor shall have the right to cause material to be inserted within each copy of the Work published, which material advertises literary, theatrical or musical works of the Proprietor but not published by Publisher. Any inquiries concerning such works shall be referred to Proprietor.

8. COPYRIGHTS:

Publisher shall promptly secure in the name of L. Ron Hubbard Library each copyright available for each of Publisher's editions of the Work. Each copyright at all times shall be the property of Proprietor alone. Each copy of the Work published by Publisher shall contain whatever copyright notice is necessary to secure and retain Proprietor's copyright on that edition of the Work, including the name of L. Ron Hubbard Library and a statement to the effect that all rights are reserved throughout the world. This paragraph is an integral part of this Agreement and the paragraph 1 publishing grant is conditioned on the printing of the correct copyright notices. Any violation of this paragraph shall be deemed conclusively to be a material breach of contract.

9. ROYALTIES:

In consideration of the rights granted to Publisher hereunder, Publisher shall pay Proprietor the following royalties calculated on Publisher's suggested retail list price (excluding turnover taxes or similar sales taxes) per copy on gross sales less returns.

- A. On hardbound editions (each volume to be regarded as a different edition) of the Work, the royalty shall be at the rate of fifteen percent (15%) on all copies sold by the Publisher.
- B. On trade paperback editions (each volume to be regarded as a different edition) of the Work, the royalty shall be at the rate of eight percent (8%) on all copies sold by the Publisher.
- C. On paperback editions (each volume to be regarded as a different edition) of the Work, the royalty shall be at the rate

by a third party to compensate both Proprietor and Publisher), the royalty payable to Proprietor shall be 50 % of that received by the Publisher but in no event less than 10% of the price upon which royalties are calculated.

E. The right to sell or license the Work to users such as libraries on a royalty basis: 75% to Proprietor, 25% to Publisher.

PROPRIETOR'S RESERVED RIGHTS:

All rights in the work not specifically granted herein to Publisher are reserved to Proprietor and may be exercised or disposed of by Proprietor at any time during the term of this Agreement, it being understood that Proprietor shall have the sole and exclusive right to the revenues generated therefrom. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Proprietor at any time may license or otherwise dispose of the rights to make any and all uses of the Work, and dramatizations and adaptations thereof, in the following media, and to sell, lease, distribute, exhibit, perform, disseminate and broadcast records, films, television recordings and other recordings, by methods now or hereafter known, of readings, performances and other presentations of the Work and adaptations and dramatizations thereof:

- A. Records, tapes or other methods of audio reproduction;
- B. Live theatre, motion pictures, free cable and pay television and radio and other means of disseminating or distributing performances;
- C. Audio/video recordings of the Work, or any dramatic, motion picture or television version of the Work, by any device or system now or hereafter known.

12. ACCOUNTINGS AND PAYMENTS:

A. Publisher shall maintain accurate books and records pertaining to the sale of copies of the Work and shall prepare semiannual statements accounting for all payments due Proprietor under this Agreement during each of the following periods in every year:

From January 1 through June 30;

From July 1 through December 31.

B. Publisher shall mail each statement to Proprietor within thirty (30) days after the close of each period. Payments due Proprietor from Publisher shall be paid weekly on a volume by volume basis and shall be accompanied by an informal statement indicating the basis for the payment.
