Dear Parents,

Please review these important requirements regarding medication at school:

- Parents must bring any medication to and from the clinic. Students are **not** permitted to carry medication with them on school grounds or on the bus. **Students found with medication of any form can be suspended from bus transportation.** This includes prescription and non-prescription medication (cough drops, ointments, over the counter medication, etc.) All medication must be supplied in the original container. No loose pills in a baggy!
- Parents must complete and sign an **Administration of Medication** form for any prescription and over the counter medications to be administered at school.
- Each time the medication dosage changes, the prescription label must reflect the change. No medication will be dispensed from “old prescription bottles.”
- If possible, all medications should be administered between classes or during lunch or recess.
