

GENERAL COMPETITION RULES

Rules

- Multiple entries will be allowed up to a maximum of 2 models per competitor
- Refunds on entry fees will only be granted if competition is cancelled.
- In all sections it is understood that all work presented was carried out by the competitor named on the entry form. Entry may be disqualified or award forfeited if not.
- No late arrivals will be allowed. The competitor and model needs to ensure they ready at least 15 minutes prior to the sections starting. PLEASE NOTE: If you intend to use your model in more than one section, or you yourself use a model in another section, please allow sufficient time for judging, as sections will not be delayed if you or your model is not in attendance at starting time.
- No competitor or model shall in any competition, display, pose or performance allow his or her genitalia to be exposed or visible to any person at any time. Political, Military uniforms or historic clothes are forbidden.
- No mobile phones will be allowed on the competition floor.
- In the event that a competitor or model sustains a wound during a competition, the competitor and their model must leave the floor until bleeding has been treated and wound securely covered.
- EOHCB reserves the right to remove any competitor from the floor who indulges in unsafe workplace or safety practices.
- Any competitor receiving coaching during the competition may be asked to leave the floor and be disqualified from participation.
- Any person disturbing competitors on the floor will be removed from the venue.
- A minimum of 2cm needs to be cut all round (from ear to ear and front to back) on ALL CUTTING SECTIONS.
- Models must not touch their own hair whilst on the competition floor.
- All competitors must stop work immediately and stand away from the model when the call to do so is given. Any further contact could result in a penalty.
- All sections will be judged as a total look (top to toe). Your model must be able to stand and sit for judging. Judges would like to see the latest in hair & fashion. Your inspiration should come from high fashion magazines, latest movie and music video fashion.
- All models to be seated upright and forward for judging, or otherwise as directed by the chairperson of judges. All models must be able to sit, stand and parade without assistance and should not hinder any other person on the judging floor.
- The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- First second and third place trophies will be awarded in all sections where numbers allow — this is pending the ballot decision from the EOHCB National Board.
- Only the EOHCB official photographer will be allowed on the competition floor.
- On completion of judging, all competitors must allow their models to be photographed by the official EOHCB photographer.
- All photos will be available through the official EOHCB social media platforms, and can be obtained from there. This is the only manner in which photos will be shared.
- Junior of the year: To be eligible for Junior of the year, competitors must enter Junior Gents Cut and style, Junior Ladies Cut and style and at least two other sections. The winner will be the person with the highest accumulation of points counting the two compulsory sections and the highest two scores of the other categories entered.
- Senior of the year: To be eligible for Senior of the year, competitors must enter Senior Gents Cut and style, Senior Ladies Cut and style and at least two other sections. The winner will be the person with the highest accumulation of points counting the two compulsory sections and the highest two scores of the other categories entered.

Liability

- Any competitor who causes damage to the competition venue will be liable for costs.
- EOHCB shall not be responsible or liable for models or for any damage arising out of work performed on models hair.

Right of admission

- EOHCB reserves the right to refuse admission to any person(s).

- EOHCB hereby grants permission to persons only using reproduction for private or educational purposes PROVIDED the reproduction is not sold in any way. You must state the fact your award was awarded in an EOHCB competition with the year and category of the award stated if you market by any media or advertising the winner of your Salon, College, Senior or Junior Award.

09:00 | Jnr Ladies Cut and Style: 40 min

(Sponsored by Valera, Andis and Complete Hairdressing supplies).

- The competitors must cut and style a current fashionable hairstyle.
- Models clothing must be current fashion.
- Artistic and fantasy styles are forbidden.
- Models hair must be wet and combed flat back before they enter the competition floor.
- Before cutting the model's hair must be a minimum of 8cm all over the head. The hair must not be pre-cut.
- All cutting and styling tools are allowed. All fixing products are allowed. Finger styling is allowed.
- Use of styling products is forbidden before the competition begins.
- Special attention will be given to the execution of colour.
- A harmonious graduation of 2 or more colour shades is compulsory. Spray colours, extensions and ornaments are forbidden.

09:10 | Wahl - Female Barber section : 30 min

(All entry fees sponsored by Wahl).

- The competitor carries out a Trendy classic gents cut on Caucasian or Afro hair
- Male Model to be used
- Barber/Stylist has to be female
- The hair must be a minimum of 2cm on the sides and back before the competition starts
- The competitor must use only WAHL clippers, all other cutting tools are allowed
- Styling products and styling equipment are allowed
- The choice of colour is free prior to the competition,
- no spray colours or any other colour products will be allowed during the competition
- The perimeter (neckline and sides) should be traditionally tapered
- The finished look should fade from a 0 to a longer trendy top
- No square or edged necklines

10:00 | Jnr Gents Cutting Section (Classic Barbering) 30 mins

(Sponsored by Valera, Andis and Complete Hairdressing supplies).

- The competitors must cut and style a current fashionable hairstyle.
- The classic barbering skills will be judged
- Models clothing must be current fashion. No historic, traditional or military wear allowed.
- Artistic and fantasy styles are forbidden.
- Models hair must be wet and combed flat back before they enter the competition floor.
- Before cutting the model's hair must be a minimum of 7cm on the top and 3cm's on the sides. The hair must not be pre-cut. At the finish the hair length at the perimeter must not be longer than 2cm.
- All cutting and styling tools are allowed. All fixing products are allowed. Finger styling is allowed
- Use of styling products is forbidden before the competition begins.
- Special attention will be given to the execution of colour.
- A harmonious graduation of 2 or more colour shades is compulsory. Spray colours, extensions and ornaments are forbidden.
- Open section: afro or Caucasian hair
- Penalties will be awarded for any pre-cutting.

10:00 | Wahl - Trendy Fade Cut (anyone may enter): 30 min

(All entry fees sponsored by Wahl)

- The competitor carries out a Trendy fade cut on straight (Caucasian) hair
- Male Model to be used
- The hair must be a minimum of 2cm on the sides and back and a minimum of 7cm on the top before the competition starts
- The competitor must use only WAHL clippers, all other cutting tools are allowed.
- Styling products and styling equipment are allowed
- Only one colour is allowed prior to the competition, no spray colours or neon colours
- The perimeter (neckline and sides) should be traditionally tapered
- The finished look should fade from a 0 to a longer trendy top, a minimum of 2cm has to be removed from the top
- No square or edged necklines

11:00 | JNR blow dry: 30min

(Sponsored by Valera, Andis and Complete Hairdressing supplies).

- The competitors must create a fashionable consumer day style by blow drying.
- The judges are not looking for a flat ironed look.
- No cutting is allowed on the competition floor.
- Models hair must be wet and combed flat back before they enter the competition floor.
- Only blow dryers, brushes and combs are allowed, no rollers.
- Smooth weaves are not allowed.
- Use of styling products is forbidden before the competition begins.
- The choice of colour is free.
- Make-up & accessories must be current and wearable.
- Models hair should not be longer than shoulder length
- This section is for First years, apprentices and multiskilled operators (not longer than 5 years in the industry)

12:00 | Bridal: 45min

- The competitor must create a current Bridal Hairstyle on Long Hair with a Total Look in mind.
- Models hair must be shoulder length or longer. Models must have open straight hair and hair must be wet or dry and combed flat back before they enter the competition floor. The hair must not be pre-styled.
- Competitors may use scissors to clean up the ends but this is not a cutting section.
- All cutting and styling tools are allowed including flat & curling irons. All fixing products are allowed.
- Use of styling products is forbidden before the competition begins.
- The use of any kind of support is forbidden.
- The choice of colour is free. A harmonious graduation of 2 or more colour shades is compulsory. Spray colours are forbidden.
- Up to 20% Hair Extensions may be used. This must be done in advance.
- Dreads or braids must be single.
- Ornaments are allowed. Ornaments must be proportional to the hairstyle and must not cover more than 25% of the entire head.

13:10 | Creative Dreads: 40min

(Anyone may enter)

- Models proceed to the Competition floor with open Straight dreadlocks.
- The hair must not be pre-styled.
- The Competitor creates a current Dread on Long Hair with a Total Look in mind.

- The Competitors may use Scissors to clean up the ends. The hair must be shoulder length or longer.
- COLOUR IS FREE - A harmonious graduation of two (2) or more colours is compulsory. This must be done in advance.
- Spray colours are forbidden.
- All products are allowed. - The use of any kind of support is forbidden.
- Ornaments must be proportional to the hairstyle and must not cover more than 30% & of the entire head. Ornaments are allowed.

14:00 | Wahl - Trendy Bold fade: 30 min

(All entry fees sponsored by Wahl).

- The competitor carries out a Trendy Bold Fade on natural curly hair(Afro) hair
- Male Model to be used
- The hair must be a minimum of 2cm on the sides, back and the top before the competition starts
- The competitor must use only WAHL clippers, all other cutting tools are allowed
- Styling products and styling equipment are allowed
- Only one colour is allowed prior to the competition,
- no spray colours or any other colour products will be allowed during the competition
- The perimeter (neckline and sides) should be traditionally tapered
- The finished look should be a BALD fade with a longer trendy top a minimum of 1cm has to be cut all around the head
- No square or edged necklines

15:00 | Avant Gardé: 40 min

- Competitors will create an avant-garde style with new ideas that are innovative, experimental and forward thinking. AHEAD OF ITS TIME
- The total look will be judged. This section is open to freedom of expression. This calls for more forward thinking shapes and methods with bold, highly pigmented or neon colours.
- Models must have open wavy or straight hair. Hair may be wet or dry and must be combed flat back before they enter the competition floor. The hair must not be pre-styled. No ornaments/support may be pre-attached.
- All Hair pieces and products are allowed.
- Competitors may use scissors to clean up the ends but this is not a cutting section.
- 50% of the ornamentation must be incorporated into the hairstyle and not used as a prop / separate attachment.
- The choice of colour is free.
- Models clothes must fit Avantgarde but no indecent attire is allowed.
- Model must be able to stand on their own.

16:00 | Braiding - CAUCASIAN & AFRO: 40min

(ANYONE MAY ENTER)

- Models proceed to the competition floor with open Straight plaited hair.
- The hair must not be pre-styled.
- The Competitor creates a Single Hairstyle on Long Hair with a Total Look in mind.
- The Competitors may use Scissors to clean up the ends. - The hair must be shoulder length or longer.
- COLOUR IS FREE - A harmonious graduation of two (2) or more colours is compulsory. This must be done in advance.
- Spray colours are forbidden.
- All products are allowed. - The use of any kind of support is forbidden.
- Ornaments must be proportional to the hairstyle and must not cover more than 30% & of the entire head. Ornaments are allowed.

10:30 | Themed Tip box Competition (Sponsored by Mia Secret)

Self-taught: 2 hrs
Beginners: 2 hrs
Intermediate: 1.5 hrs
Advanced: 1 hr

- All health, safety and hygiene rules apply
- This section may be entered by nail technicians.
- No live models will be allowed.
- The free hand nail art should follow the provided theme: Vegas / Casino
- Competitors must create 5 nails, of which one (1) should be accentuated and display the provided theme (3D).
- A small card should be visible on the judging table promoting your inspiration.
- A pre-applied base product or 1 colour over tips will be allowed prior to the start of the competition and will serve as a base for the nail art. Only 1 colour to be applied prior as a base.
- The display presentation of Tips/Art will add to the overall score. Examples of displaying Box Art include but not limited to; photo frames, boxes, cardboard, plates or paper.
- The size of the display medium may not exceed an A4 page or be less than an A5 page.
- Any 3D art and medium may be used but not exceeding 1/2 cm in height or over the tip sides. Examples include but not limited to: acrylic paints, gel polish, brushes, colour shapers, sponges, dotting tools, rhinestones, pearls, studs, glitters, leathers, foils, nail polish, paper base coats, top coats.
- Any length tip, shape and designed enhancement may be applied.
- Filigree enhancements may be created as long as the enhancements side walls and structure remain in line with the complete enhancement and as per competition rules (within 1/2 cm) and is done on the competition floor.
- No pre-designed tips with printed images or patterned tips or any form of decal stickers may be used.
- No stamping, water transfer art or wraps or any pre-prepared acrylic add-on is allowed.
- Airbrushing is strictly prohibited.
- Contestants must provide all their own equipment: products, art tools, lamps, extension cables, plugs and props.
- Before the commencement of the section, the tips will be pre-judged for pre-applied nail enhancements. This is to ensure that points are awarded to all work done on the floor only and not beforehand. No prior artwork may be performed prior to the start of the competition.

11:00 | Wax on Hair off – Depilve: 20 Minutes

- Competitors will only be allowed Cold (strip) wax with spatula application.
- A male or female model is allowed.
- No models with contra indications for waxing is allowed.
- Evidence in the form of a consultation card is expected.
- It is expected of the competitor to wax only 1 (one) forearm.
- Hair length should be at least 0.5 – 1cm.
- Only one arm will be judged.
- Special attention will be given to the execution of the technique.
- Appropriate aftercare application and recommendations.
- After judging is completed, and the judges has left the floor, the competitor will be afforded an additional 15 minutes to wax the other arm of his/her model.

12:30 | Stage/Fantasy Make up: 90 minutes (Sponsored by 27 Red and Stageline)

- All health, safety and hygiene rules apply
- Own equipment / tools and products
- Safe discarding of cotton wool / make-up sponges/wedges. This section may be entered by Make-up artist.
- One female model per competitor.
- Competitor must be a current student/learner enrolled and training at a make-up academy/studio, recent graduate (within past 12 months) or qualified (with more than 12 months experience).
- The competitor is to create a face and neck that captures and illustrates the theme and its diversity, allowing the judges to be transported to experience a walk down the Vegas Strip or living the High Rollers life in the Casino's and Theatres. The judges might even be encapsulated by illusionist or take a selfie with a famous impersonator...
- No assistants will be permitted. The competitor must apply all make-up by him/herself.
- The model must arrive with no make-up on prior to the start of the competition. If models arrive with make-up on, they will be required to remove it.
- The model will be judged from the collar bone and up. Headdresses and accessories may be used to compliment the finish look and theme (Vegas / Casino).
- All competitors must supply their own products, tools and equipment.
- Nudity is not allowed. Only black fabric attire will be allowed (top corset/boob tube/strapsless).
- Prosthetic applications will not be allowed. Stickers, lace, beads, crystals etc. are allowed.
- Competitors will be judged based on the following criteria: Reflection of Theme, Design, Application Technique, Use of Colour and Overall Presentation.

14:15 | Collection of the year: 15 minutes

- This section is open to anyone.
- All work must be pre-done and competitors will have only 15 minutes to setup and position their models, ready for judging.

The competing salon needs to enter 3 (three) competitors, each with 1 model.

Competitor 1 - Model 1: short length hair

Competitor 2 - Model 2: medium length hair – above shoulders

Competitor 3 - Model 3: long length hair – below shoulder

- Models from previous cutting sections may be used, but remember that your models need to tie in with each other and represent your collection and the theme.
- Male and/or female models may be used and models may wear weaves/extensions.

The judging of this collection and each model will be based on:

1. The cut
2. The colour (a minimum of two harmonious colours are required)
3. The styling of the hair
4. The total look
5. The interpretation of the theme

- The collection must be named to indicate where the inspiration for the collection was derived from.
- This section will be judged as a total look and theme; therefore attire, accessories and makeup need to compliment the total look and theme.
- Models may be seated or standing.
- Strictly, no props will be allowed.
- Incented attire and/or any form of sexual or discriminating influences contributing to the collection and total look is forbidden.

Jnr overall EOHCB | Gents & Ladies Cut Colour Style + any 2 other sections

Overall Winner EOHCB | Most accumulated points over the two days (enter as many sections as possible)
