- Poets who enter work into the Annette Cameron Encouragement Award must be over 18 and unpublished (this specifically means that the entrant has never published a full collection of poetry, either in print or online),
- Open style, open theme, traditional or contemporary.
- Limit of three poems per author. Individual poems cannot be entered in more than one section.
- Entries to be typed on one side only of A4 white paper, with pages numbered and poem title on each page. Post in an A4-sized envelope (C4).
- To ensure anonymity NO WRITERS' NAMES TO APPEAR ON MS. Please attach a COVER SHEET with title of poem, line count, Section entered, and age if Young Writer.
- MS will not be returned and will be destroyed after the competition, so keep a copy of your work.
- Results and judges' reports will be posted on the KSP website on Monday 4 December 2017.
- Shortlisted award winners will be notified by phone or email prior to announcement at the Katharine Susannah Prichard Writers' Centre on Sunday 3 December 2017, when those winners able to attend will be invited to read excerpts from their poems.
- The KSP Competitions Secretary and the KSP Board of Management are not allowed to enter.
- Award placements are issued only by discretion of the judge in the event of a worthy winning entry. The judges' decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The KSP Foundation Inc. reserves the right to publish the winning entry or entries online or in a publication related to KSP should the opportunity occur, in consultation with the author.
- Mundaring Community Financial Services as the competition sponsor retains the right to publish the winning entries in publicity materials whilst authorship and copyright remain with the author.
