

Dawn of a Sunny Century

'Dawn of a Sunny Century' includes 40 paintings selected from Dr. Suen's Yitao Collection, and some of them are making their public debut in this exhibition. The exhibition explores the artists' journey in search of truth and novelty, based on the trends and changes of Chinese art in the last century. Created in the 20th century, the works witness the era of social reformation and the critical moment of Chinese art. The invaluable exhibits, painted by Chinese masters, including Qi Baishi, Huang Binhong, Xu Beihong, Zhang Daqian, Lin Fengmian, Wu Guanzhong and Jao Tsung I, carry a rich variety of styles of Chinese painting. Chloe Suen, the chairman of Simon Suen Foundation, said 'We hope that Sun Museum can serve as a platform to facilitate the development of arts and culture in Hong Kong, as well as to promote traditional Chinese arts and culture.' Yeung Chun-tong, Director of Sun Museum, hopes the opening exhibition could bring a brand new experience to the public by introducing them the history and aesthetic value of Chinese paintings.
