Thanks for picking up a copy of Ashtabula County's first ever **Local Food Guide!**

This guide was developed by the Ashtabula County Master Gardener Volunteers, the Ashtabula Local Foods Council, and Ashtabula County Community Action Agency as part of a larger project to help promote local foods and healthy eating.

For our definition "local" means those farms that are located in or sell in Ashtabula County. We included as many farms as we could find! We gathered names, sent surveys, and made follow up phone calls in order to include the most accurate and up to date information. In some cases, perhaps due to the spring weather, we were unable to talk to farms directly. In these cases, we just included information from their website. Every effort was made to ensure the information is accurate; however, we encourage readers to double check websites for open hours before attempting to visit a farm. And, please only visit farms that indicate they sell "on farm"! Many farms sell only through markets or other avenues and cannot accommodate unscheduled visitors.

That said, we really encourage you to get out there and explore all of the abundance that Ashtabula County has to offer! We challenge you to find new local sources of food and to increase the amount of local products you are consuming. By eating locally, you contribute to the local economy, preserve open farm land, and support many small businesses.

How does it work?

Anyone is welcome to take seeds out from the library and plant them at home. Take as many packets as you think you will use.

At the end of the growing season, collect seed from your plants and donate them back to the library. Seed-saving classes are held by Red Beet Row and the libraries.
