We are delighted to invite teachers, children and parents from across the world to attend the **2018 Great Malvern Suzuki Flute & Suzuki Recorder Summer School** at Malvern St James, in Great Malvern, UK.

Malvern St James (www.malvernstjames.co.uk) is an independent girls school that is situated near the centre of Great Malvern. It will be home to our combined Suzuki Flute and Suzuki Recorder Summer Workshop where teachers and students can meet to widen their experience of Suzuki repertoire and share opportunities for great music-making.

The students' course

Students who have studied the Suzuki recorder repertoire are invited to join us for four fun-filled days of master classes, group lessons, repertoire classes, recorder consort playing and daily concerts. The course begins with a play together at 5pm, followed by dinner, concert and a Ceilidh on 1st August and finishes after lunch on 5th August. On the Saturday evening there will be a public concert at Christ Church.

All repertoire should be committed to memory.

There will be three Students' Concerts during the course. Students need to submit their concert piece on applying to the course so the programmes can be balanced in advance. It should be a piece you are currently performing, not the piece you expect to play in your masterclass and substitutions are not allowed.

The swimming pool at the school is fabulous and has been booked for us for Thursday and Friday afternoons – chance for everyone to go at least once!

Students under 16 must be accompanied by an adult who will be responsible for them.

Accommodation

Accommodation with all meals is available at Malvern St James, with single to 6-bedded rooms which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Bedding and towels are provided but you will need to bring toiletries and your own towels for swimming.

Arrival and Departure. Participants may arrive from 4pm on 1st August and must vacate their rooms by 10am on 5th August.

Special diets can be catered for; please state your needs when you book.

Camping is available on site at Malvern St James; meals can be booked with the school. Campers may arrive from 3pm on 1st August and must leave by 3pm on 5th August. The campsite is near the sports centre and is suitable for tents and campervans. This is a five minute walk from the main building. Shower facilities are available in the sports centre from 7am – 11pm daily and you will have 24hr access to the cricket pavilion for water and WC.

Recreation

Malvern St James has many enclosed grassy areas for children to play; we will have the use of the **Gym** and the **Tennis Courts**. The **Sports Hall, The Dome** (another sports hall) and the **Climbing Wall** will all be available to book. We will book the **Swimming Pool** for two sessions during the course.

The **Course Timetable** will be available at the beginning of the course and will list the variety of events that are arranged for each day. In addition to classes, concerts and lessons, there will be swimming and “entertainment” to make the course a rewarding experience for everyone.

How to get to Malvern St James

Malvern St James is at the heart of Great Malvern; the main entrance is opposite Great Malvern railway station and is very easy to find.

AIR

Birmingham International Airport (closest) – from here take the train to Great Malvern via Birmingham New Street; this takes 1½ hours. Tickets can be purchased at www.gwr.com

Bristol International Airport – from here take the Bristol Airport Flyer (coach) to Bristol Temple Meads railway station, then take the train to Great Malvern. This usually takes under 3 hours (bus & train journey). Combined tickets can be purchased at www.gwr.com

London Heathrow – from here take RailAir to Reading, 45 minutes (www.railair.com), then the train to Great Malvern, around 2½ hours train journey.

London Gatwick – from here take the train to Great Malvern via Reading, around 4 hours.

At **junction 8** on the **M5** join the **M50**

Leave the **M50** at **junction 1**, take the **A38** towards Malvern, Upton & Worcester

After 3 miles turn left onto the **A4104** to Upton

Go over the river in **Upton** then **turn right** at the round-a-bout, onto **B4211**

Continue **through Hanley Castle**, then **turn left to Guarford**, still the **B4211**

You will reach **Barnard's Green** – bakery, cheese shop, cobblers & Co-op

Go around the Green and take the **first left, Avenue Road**

Malvern St James is a little way up this road on your right

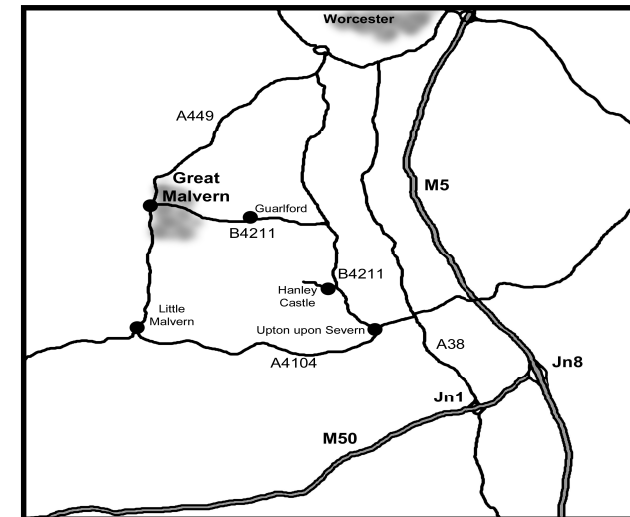
COACH

Malvern St James nestles just below the town centre on the slopes of the Malvern Hills. The school is 10 minutes walk from the middle of town. Great Malvern is a **Victorian** town famous for still having 22 original **gas lamps**. The town centre has many cafés, pubs, restaurants and unique clothes retailers. Thousands walk the **Malvern Hills** each year, in search of the diverse flora and fauna, the springs, and the magnificent hilltop views. These can extend as far as the Welsh Black Mountains and the Cotswold Hills. The hills have inspired many local artists, and you will find small **Art Galleries** in the town displaying their work. Also in the town centre are **Malvern Museum of Local History**, **Malvern Theatres** (including a **Cinema**), the **Winter Gardens** and **Malvern Priory**.
