Introduction

The ***Terrain Response Experience*** series of training courses are specifically designed for late-model Land Rover products fitted with Terrain Response (TR). These courses are run regularly around Australia in affiliation with Green Oval Experience and the premier training organisations in each state. The 2017 Level 2 Sand Mastery event is scheduled for the 14th and 15th of April, 2018. The venue is 3 ½ hrs from Sydney, at The Big 4 Great Lakes in Forster Tuncurry; 1 Baird St, Tuncurry (ph 6554 6827).

Meeting and Itinerary

Participants will meet at the venue, at 11:45am on the 25th February 2017. It is your responsibility to be in time for this initial drivers' meeting. You can book into the venue either Friday night or the Saturday morning (see below for booking info).

Sat 14th :

- 11:45 – meet at GOE campsite
- 12:15 – theory session over lunch (participants to provide or purchase)
- 1:45 – driver training
- 5pm – return to camp
- 5:45 – sum-up and overview of the day

Sun 15th :

- 8:30am – meet at GOE campsite
- 9:00am – driver training
- 12 noon – lunch at cafe
- 12:30 pm – final driver session
- 2pm – return to camp, sum-up and overview of the weekend

Costs

Additional Costs

Equipment

Participants should bring the following equipment, or contact us to arrange a loan item:

- snatch strap (min 10000 kg)
- 2 rated shackles
- Max Trax or equivalent
- UHF radio
- air-down tool (ARB, Staun)
- air compressor (preferably min of 75 l/min) and tyre pressure gauge
- gloves
- drinking water
- Clothing suitable for any possible weather conditions, rain jacket, solid shoes, a hat

We will provide all other recovery, diagnostic and repair equipment when required.
