Adsorb spilled product and place in a sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Seek advice from local authority regarding disposal.					
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. This product is combustible. Decomposition products in a fire are toxic and or irritant. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus.
