ROSELLE COPELAND STEWARDSHIP AWARD

The **Roselle Copeland Stewardship Award** is presented to an **individual member** of the NCCAA. Nominees shall have been in good standing with the Association not less than two (2) years. This award focuses on exemplary individual contributions to the Association, to the local community or agency and/or the low-income community at large.

LONNIE D. BURTON ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The **Lonnie D. Burton Achievement Award** is presented annually to an **individual** who, through the assistance of a Community Action Program, has achieved a significant level of self-sufficiency and independence while recognition is given to the local Community Action Agency's role in helping the nominee(s) help themselves. This award focuses on the personal progress and achievements of the individuals nominated.

GLORIA M. WILLIAMS AWARD

The **Gloria M. Williams Award** is presented annually to a **corporation, foundation, or other valuable partner** that has advanced the cause of the Association or one of its members.
