Why Does This Still Bother Me? The Impact of Trauma

Session Description: Many of us have had experiences in our lives that have had such an impact on us we

always remember them. What happens if, when we remember them, it's not always good? Can that

change?

Objectives: Participants will learn about the concepts of traumatic memory and triggers. Participants will

have an understanding of why these are different than "typical" memories and emotions and will

engage in a discussion of ways these can occur in youth advocacy roles. After a brief overview of

Sanctuary™ concepts and principles, participants will created a highly individualized "Take 5" safety plan

with a multi-media focus to utilize when triggers occur.
