BCANY Working with USA Basketball

Dear Coaches,

The Basketball Coaches Association of New York has taken an important step to join the national standard of youth basketball by offering the USA Basketball Coach License courses at our 36th Annual Fall Clinic!

USA Basketball is the National Governing Body for basketball in the United States, responsible for the selection and training of USA National Teams. USA Basketball also is responsible for youth development initiatives that focus on player development and safety, coach education and licensing.

Below are some of the extraordinary benefits of becoming a licensed USA Basketball Licensed Coach. Upon the completion of the clinic, you may begin the licensing process, by visiting community.usab.com to create your account. After selecting your license type, you will be prompted for payment based on your selection. On your dashboard is where you will complete the last component of licensing, which is the background screening. USA Basketball will manually update your account to reflect the live training that you received for the Youth Development and Safesport Course. If you select the GOLD license, you will have one additional course to complete. Please allow 1-2 business days to obtain credit for both courses.

WHY SHOULD YOU BECOME LICENSED?

Licensing from USA Basketball is much more than a seal of approval, it's a comprehensive set of initiatives, tools and resources – all of which focus on enhancing enjoyment, safety and development for young people through basketball.

Obtaining a license through USA Basketball involves completing online courses and a background check. Once licensed, in addition to recognition as an official licensed coach of USA Basketball, you will have access to the following:

COACHING EDUCATION - Leverage this robust [guidebook of curriculum](#) at all playing levels.

ONLINE RESOURCES - Access to player skill videos, coaching tools parent resources and so much more.

COACHING INSURANCE - General liability insurance as a benefit throughout the licensing year.

FEATURED CLINIC SPEAKER



Don Showalter

Head Coach/Youth Division Director of Coach Development
USA Basketball

Eight-time USA Basketball gold medalist head coach Don Showalter, who was hired by the USA Basketball Youth Division as the Director of Coach Development in May 2016, was announced as the head coach of the 2017 USA Men's U16 National Team on March 2, 2017.

"I am looking forward to organizing a team comprised of the top U16 players in the country," Showalter said. "It is a challenge to take the top, young players and instill the USA Basketball culture of teamwork, defense and unselfish play. The FIBA Americas U16 tournament will be extremely competitive. To represent USA Basketball in international competition is the highest honor for any coach and I look forward to the challenge."

Most recently, Showalter led the 2016 USA Basketball Men's U17 National Team to a gold medal and 7-0 record at the 2016 FIBA U17 World Championship in Zaragoza, Spain.

A high school coach for 42 years and a seven-time USA Basketball Developmental Coach of the Year award winner, Showalter owns a perfect 50-0 record at the helm of USA Basketball U16 and U17 teams.

Further, Showalter was the U.S. Olympic Committee 2012 Volunteer Coach of the Year.

In addition to winning gold medals for the USA, Showalter has returned to Colorado Springs, Colorado, for eight fall training camps to help prepare the USA Basketball Men's Junior National Team for future competitions.

Showalter was the USA head coach in the 1998 Nike Hoop Summit and for the North Team in the 1998 USA Basketball Men's Youth Development Festival. He was the coordinator for a youth clinic hosted by USA Basketball in New York in 2004, and he served as chair of the USA Basketball Cadet and Youth Committee (now the Developmental National Team Committee) from 2001-08.

Showalter compiled a 601-346 overall record (.635 winning percentage) during his 42 seasons as a high school head, including 16 district titles and six state tournament appearances.

In 2015-16, his fourth and final year at Iowa City High School, his team finished 13-10, was a co-champion of the Mississippi Division of the Mississippi Valley Conference, and Showalter was named the 2016 Mississippi Valley Division Coach of the Year in the MVC.

While at Mid-Prairie High School (Iowa) from 1984-85 to 2011-12, Showalter tallied a 446-202 (.688) record, and in eight seasons (1976-84) as the head coach at Central Elkader High School (Iowa), he totaled a 108-63 (.632) record.

Showalter earned the 2004 National Association of Basketball Coaches Advocacy Award. In 2009, he was honored by the National High School Athletic Coaches Association as the National Coach of the Year, and he was an Iowa Basketball Coaches Association Coach of the Year 10 times (1981, 1982, 1991, 1995, 1996, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2010 and 2016).

Showalter has been recognized by numerous organizations for his dedication to the game. In 2004 he earned the NABC Advocacy Award. In 2009 Showalter was honored by the National High School Athletic Coaches Association as its National, Regional and State Coach of the Year after having been named the Iowa Basketball Coaches Association's Coach of the Year nine times (1981, 1982, 1991, 1995, 1996, 2006-2008, 2010).

In addition to his high school coaching duties, Showalter was selected to coach in the 1999 McDonald's High School All-America Game and the 2005 and 2012 Jordan Brand Classic All-Star Games. He has been a coach at the Nike Skills Academy and LeBron Academy and has also spoken at basketball clinics around the world, including in Australia, Belgium, Dubai, Egypt, England, Italy, Russia, Scotland, Spain (Canary Islands) and Switzerland.

Up next for Showalter is leading the ninth-annual USA Basketball Men's Junior National Team October minicamp, which will take place Oct. 7-8 at the United States Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colorado, is expected to feature 54 of the USA's top, high school boys basketball players, including 15 gold medalists. The player invitations were sent by the USA Basketball Men's Developmental National Team Committee.

The minicamp will be led by **Don Showalter**, head coach of the 2018 USA U17 World Cup Team and USA Basketball director of coach development. "This minicamp will be extremely competitive as we are bringing the top seniors in the country along with the top U17 players together," said Showalter, who has guided USA Basketball to nine-straight gold medals as head coach of the USA Men's U16 and U17 National Teams since 2009.
