

Brownsville Area High School/Middle School Grade Check Policy

- I. At the end of each week, athlete eligibility is checked by the Athletic Department. Teachers receive a booklet with the names of athletes in their classes. Teachers may mark a “P” for passing an “F” for failing or a “W” for a warning if a student is in danger of failing or an “I” if the grade is incomplete and the student can make up the work. If a student has two or more “F’s” in any week, the student is ineligible to compete the following week. The grades that are reported are cumulative grades.
- II. At the end of a marking period, the student’s final grades will be used to determine eligibility. If a student has failed two or more classes, then he/she becomes ineligible to compete for the first 15 school days of the next marking period.
- III. At the end of the school year, a student’s final course grades will be used to determine eligibility.
- IV. Incomplete grades are considered non-passed subjects with a value of 55%. If an incomplete is recorded on the student’s final grades, it is counted as an “F” until the grade is made-up to a minimum of 65%.
