

Brownsville Area High School Fan Behavior and Sportsmanship

Spectators in attendance at all school events are expected to have fun by demonstrating positive enthusiasm without causing harm, danger or embarrassment to the others or to the school. Spectators are to demonstrate respect towards opponents, players, coaches and officials and respect and pride for BAHS. Students should be reminded that all school rules are in effect at school athletic events.

WHAT IS SPECIFICALLY EXPECTED

- Proper language is to be used. No profanity or offensive language will be tolerated. High school events are family activities....Vulgarity is unacceptable as is verbal harassment of players, coaches and/or officials.
- Obscene gestures are unacceptable
- The throwing of objects at any individual or onto the playing surface could result in injury and/or the team being penalized by the officials.
- Work together with the cheerleaders for positive chants and avoid obscene or degrading cheers.
- Do not tease or belittle the opponent in any way....Remember, they are not enemies, but teenagers who happen to attend other schools.
- Stand, remain still and be quiet during the playing/singing of the National Anthem.
- After the contest, leave the stadium, gym or playing surface in a timely manner. Allow time for the team to meet with the coaches after the game.
