Terms and Conditions of registration & subscriptions

General

Athletic Youth FC is a members club affiliated to the Surrey Football Association (referred to as The Club)

The club provides football, sporting and social activities for registered players and player's families in good faith and using their best endeavours. It is non-profit making, there are no beneficiaries apart from the members themselves.

Registration & Data

Player registration is carried out on-line. It is the parents/players responsibility to ensure all data and information is correct.

All personal data provided to the club is maintained in line with the data protection act. We will not sell or give your data to anyone.

If players or parents/guardian fail to attend agreed registration appointments at the club then it may be that the player's registration will be delayed. If two registration appointments are missed then an £11 administration charge will be made to cover the costs of staff for the hour.

Subscriptions

Membership subscriptions are paid by members to cover the costs of the organisation, facilitation and administration of sporting activities including training, equipment, coaching, officiation and fixtures.

In registering for a membership subscription the player and his/her parent/guardian are committing to pay the subscription for the whole season. The costs of running the team do not change if one or more players decides not to take part, so if for any reason the player does not take part in the whole season's activities then there is no discount or refund.

Activities

It is the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian of the player to ensure that the player attends training, matches and other club/team activities. If a player regularly fails to attend then the Club reserves the right to take disciplinary action.

All sporting activities come with a risk of injury. In rare cases those injuries can be serious. Whilst the club and its managers use their best endeavours to reduce these risks they cannot be held liable for any injury to players. All sporting activities are carried out at the member's sole risk. The player must wear weather-appropriate clothing and suitable body protection (shin guards etc.) at all times.

Insurance

Each player will benefit from a basic level of insurance against injury. This should not

be assumed to be sufficient to fully compensate for or cover the costs of injury. The player's parent should take out their own insurance if more comprehensive cover is needed.

Code of Conduct

All players, parents and team officials must abide by the club's code of conduct. The club operates a zero-tolerance approach to poor conduct whether in retaliation or not. Players, parents or officials who materially breach conduct rules will be asked to leave the club. It is every parents/players/officials responsibility to report poor conduct to the club, this can be done on line from our web site.

The club operate an on-line knowledgebase for the answering of questions about the club and team. There is no central telephone helpline.

Fines

Players are responsible for paying fines that may be levied by the league or FA for conduct. This may include red and yellow cards. The club will notify the player (or player's parent) by email and the fine must be paid prior to taking part in any further fixtures.

The fine will be doubled if the yellow/red card is for decent or violent conduct

The fine will be tripled if the player plays a fixture before the fine is paid

It is the players/players parent's responsibility to ensure that the club have the correct email address and that you have registered the club email as a "safe sender" in your email client.

Ground Rules

The club regularly uses facilities at Carshalton Athletic FC. The player, parent and their guests must abide by all ground rules, both on and off the pitch.

Players, coaches and managers can only enter the pitch wearing clean and appropriate footwear as described on our web site and at the ground.

Training & Pitch hire rules

The Club Hires facilities from Carshalton Athletic FC. We are responsible to set up goals and pitch markings and leave the pitch as we found it. Teams are responsible to ensure that both ground rules and pitch rules are maintained at all times. Especially, but not limited to:

1. Clean footwear
2. Recommended footwear
3. Handle club equipment with care, especially goals
4. Clear area of all litter, bottles, tape after use, regardless of whether home or away team
5. No chewing gum under any circumstances
6. No swinging on goals
7. Leaving changing rooms as they were found
8. Parking in the designated car park

To maintain the quality of the facility, The Senior Club operate a 3-strikes-and-you are-out policy. If the same team is reported three times in one season for breach of these or any other ground rules they will be asked to train and play at another venue for the rest of the season.
