The Baptist Student Union logo is a reminder of the BSU goals in its ministry to students as well as its relationship with the Missouri University of Science and Technology. Its main elements are the star symbol, a gear and two pickaxes.

Baptist Campus Ministries' Two-Directional Symbol

The star symbol represents the two-directional thrust of the BSU and of an individual Christian's life. The inward direction (or inward journey) is symbolized by five arrows pointing inward to Christ at the center. The outward direction (outward journey) is symbolized by five arrows pointing outward "to the ends of the earth." It is vital that the BSU at Missouri S&T reflects this balanced concept of the Christian life.

The Inward Journey's **5** Aspects of Growth — "***Come, learn from me***" (Matt. 11:28-29)

1. Worship God — (Colossians 3:16).
2. Study God's Word — (Acts 17:11).
3. Active, Biblical Discipleship — (Colossians 3:17, 23-24).
4. Authentic Fellowship — (Acts 4:32).
5. Church Life — (1 Corinthians 12:12-13, 27)

The Outward Journey's **5** Aspects of Outreach — "***Go and make disciples***" (Matt. 28:19)

1. Missional Evangelism — (Acts 1:8).
2. Missions Beyond Campus — (Acts 13:1-3).
3. Service — (Luke 4:16-19).
4. Engage International Students — (Deuteronomy 10:19).
5. Involve — Reaching out to more students (Isaiah 54:2).
