The \$1500 Program Fee Includes:

- 1. Three days initial in-service training. (June).
- 2. Fall update for 1st and 2nd year. (BAM).
- 3. Web based curriculum and class support for two years.
- 4. Standards Material including Common Formative and Summative Assessments

All educators are encouraged to attend. In addition to new materials, veteran teachers will walk energized for the subject. New teachers will jump years ahead in classroom management and curriculum development. Notification of acceptance into the program will be by May 15th of the current year.
