DONALD CARDINAL WUERL, B '63

Donald Cardinal Wuerl, B '63, is the Archbishop of Washington and was elevated to the College of Cardinals in 2010 by Pope Benedict XVI. He participated in the March 2013 conclave which elected Pope Francis.



His Eminence was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and studied as a Basselin Scholar at Theological College, received graduate degrees from The Catholic University of America, the Gregorian University in Rome and earned a doctorate in theology from the University of Saint Thomas in Rome. He was ordained a bishop by Pope John Paul II on January 6, 1986, in Saint Peter's Basilica, Rome. He served as Auxiliary Bishop in Seattle until 1987 and then as Bishop of Pittsburgh for 18 years until his appointment to Washington. His titular church in Rome is Saint Peter in Chains.

Cardinal Wuerl hosted Pope Benedict XVI in Washington, DC in April 2008 and Pope Francis in September 2015 during their first pastoral visits to the United States. He was appointed by Pope Benedict XVI to help direct the October 2012 Synod of Bishops on *The New Evangelization for the Transmission of the Christian Faith*. Cardinal Wuerl was also appointed by Pope Francis as a member of both the 2014 and the 2015 Synods on the Family.

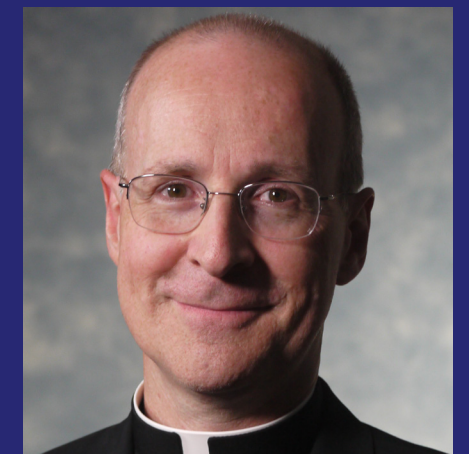
