In order to qualify for the Mrs. Fedelia Adokailey Mensah Scholarship Award the scholar must be able to meet the following requirements:

1. **Actively enrolled in school & no more than five occurrences of lateness / un-excused absences**
2. **Maintain credit grades A & B throughout calendar school year (GPA of 3.0 and above)**
3. **Scholar must have a minimum of 40 hours on volunteer log**
4. **No prior outstanding tuition balances**
