PBCHA's Local Preference

The PHA will offer a preference to any family that has been terminated from its HCV program due to insufficient program funding. The PHA will offer a preference for working families, where the head, spouse or sole member is employed for at least 20 hours a week. However, an applicant where the head and spouse or sole member is a person age 62 or older, or is a person with disabilities, must also be given the benefit of this preference. The PHA will also offer a preference for homeless families. A homeless family is a household that is (1) living on the street, in an emergency shelter or in a transitional housing facility, or (2) is a client of a case-management program service for the homeless. The PHA will offer a preference for displaced families, a family in which each member, or whose sole member, is a person displaced by governmental action, or a person whose dwelling has been extensively damaged or destroyed as a result of a disaster declared or otherwise formally recognized pursuant to Federal disaster relief laws.
