

Over the last decade, science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) has expanded rapidly in the out-of-school time field . There has been substantial growth in not only the numbers of STEM programs, but in the diversity of programming offered. While the availability of a multitude of learning opportunities has been shown to have many benefits to the children and youth who participate in STEM programs, the rapid growth of the field

has also presented a unique challenge to practitioners and researchers, who now need an ever increasing range of measurement tools to monitor the quality and outcomes of these afterschool STEM programs.
