1.	Do you hope to see again those you love who have passed away?
2.	How do we have a sure and certain hope of spending eternity with those we love in the paradise that God has prepared for all who trust in Jesus?
3.	How does someone become a saint? How is someone saved? The Progression revealed in Romans 10:9-17 • If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. As Scripture says, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord" Romans 10:9, 13
	What does it mean to "call on the name of the Lord"?
	 Then Paul asks four questions in verses 14-15a: 1) How, then, can they call on the one they have notin? 2) And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not

	3) And how can they hear without someone to them?
	4) And how can anyone preach unless they ?
	 Then Paul concludes, Consequently, faith comes from the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ. Romans 10:17 Summary of this progression to a saving faith:

 - 2) 1-degree Growth in my Outreach Temperature
 - 3) 30-day Check-in to experience Teaching, Coaching, Inspiration, and Accountability.
 - Congregational Behavior Change.
 - 1) Change in understanding our structure to focus on outreach
 - 2) 2-Degree Shift. Vectoring everything to include outreach
 - 3) Sharing faith stories
