Physical Lab is an international laboratory for acting and performance.

We work with ensemble training practices alongside one to one training, focusing on individualised professional development. Our methodology utilises body and voice, intellect and imagination, and all tools available to the performing artist. The participants engage consciously and subconsciously to create authentic, responsive performances.

Over two intensive days we will work with text from scripts or screenplays. We will engage with techniques including physical grounding, emotional exploration, identifying acting habits, scene study and character building.

The aim is to assist actors to build their own technique/ways into acting.
