

## Jerry Beckendorf Community Service Scholarship

### Scholarship Guidelines

The Jerry Beckendorf Community Service Scholarship encourages future generations of Union activists and volunteers by recognizing outstanding student community service. Since 2003, more than \$120,000 has been raised to provide awards to 117 graduating seniors of Union families living in Pierce County. A long-time community leader, Jerry Beckendorf, retired from United Way of Pierce County after working 15 years as the United Way and Pierce County Labor Council's Labor Liaison. His commitment and efforts to build a better community continue to impact the lives of Pierce County residents.

The intention of this scholarship is to reward graduating seniors who are dedicated to giving back to their community through community service. Greater consideration is given to the quality and amount of community service done by each applicant. The scholarship committee seeks to reward students that look beyond themselves and reach out to an issue faced by our society (i.e. poverty, abuse, homelessness). Volunteer service will be considered for leadership roles, and can be defined as helping others when or where it is needed, but does not necessarily address a social issue.

#### Scholarship Availability & Amount of Award

The scholarship is a one-time award. On average, seven scholarships are granted each year, totaling \$7,000.

#### Scholarship Qualifications and Requirements

The primary award criteria is as follows:

- Applicant must be a high school student in Pierce County, Washington
- Parent(s) or *legal* guardian(s) must be a member of a labor union (guardians can be a grandparent or other family member)
- Student must plan to attend college or university, community college or junior college, trade, or technical school in the fall of 2018

Students applying for this scholarship must submit the following:

- Application form
- Guardian's Union membership verification form
- Letter of recommendation
- Essay describing the overall impact of your community service, the leadership skills you have learned in the process, and your commitment to service
- Completed community service experience form

#### Scholarship Application Submissions

## Application Instructions & Checklist

Application Deadline: Postmarked by March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018

1. Application must be filled out by the applicant. Please type or print clearly. All requirements must be met and all forms must be completed and submitted in order to be considered.
2. Fill out your community service history with a brief description of your service experience.
3. Include one letter of recommendation from a teacher or other adult (not a parent) that speaks to your character, leadership, and community service experience. **These can be submitted separately, but must be turned in.**
4. Attach an essay of no more than 750 words describing the overall impact of your community service, the leadership skills you have learned in the process, and your commitment to service. **Applications without essays will not be considered; do not send essays separately.**
5. The union verification form must be completed and signed by an officer of the member's local and submitted with the application. **Applications without completed union verification form will not be considered; do not send union verification form separately.**
6. Retain a copy of the completed application for your files. Mail completed application to:
