Cancellation: The tournament committee reserves the right to cancel any event or combine events if there are insufficient entries. Fees refunded for any cancelled event.

Eligibility: The High School Team Championships are reserved for secondary schools located in the State of Rhode Island (and the teams must be made up of current students of those schools – though those students do not have to reside in Rhode Island). Individual entrants in the Age Events must reside in the State of Rhode Island, or be full-time students at RI schools, or be a member of a RI table tennis club. All events are co-ed except for the Girls' event (which is limited to female participants). This is not sanctioned by the USATT, so no membership fees or sanctioning fees are required to participate.

Event Seeding: Where applicable, USATT rating will be applied to seed players. Some effort will be made to appropriately seed players based upon information available on the tournament day. It is possible that unrated players will be seeded by random draw.

When will the doors be opened? The Manville Community Center will open Sunday at 8am.

Event Format and criteria:

SINGLES EVENTS: All singles events will begin with round robin groups of 3-5 players with the top one or two of each group advancing to single elimination. All matches will be best 3 out of 5 (11 point) games.

3-PERSON TEAM EVENT: The High School Championship will be a "3-Man" Team event in which three players "A, B, and C" will play against three players "X, Y, and Z" in singles competition ("Team Match"). The winning team will be the first team to win twice. The top player on each team will play first (ie "A" versus "Z"), then the second player on each team (ie "B" versus "Y"), and then the final match if needed (ie "C" versus "Z"). Players may only compete in one set of games per Team Match.

Tournament director has discretion to limit the number of entries in each event, or to combine events due to lack of entries.

Rules: The Laws of Table Tennis as published by the ITTF and all USATT regulations apply. The Point Penalty System will be used in umpired matches. Any questions/disputes will be resolved by the tournament referee. **For events with young and beginning players, and where the result will not be drastically changed, we reserve the right to relax service rules (at the discretion of the Umpire presiding).**

Equipment: Tables: Butterfly (6); **Nets:** Butterfly; **Balls:** Butterfly 3-star poly ball 40+ white; **Floors:** Hard wood. Players must supply their own rackets (some rackets will be available in the club on loan if necessary).

***Note: Rackets** - One side of the racket must be bright red, the other side must be black, whether or not both sides are used for striking the ball. The racket may not be changed in a match unless it is (accidentally) broken.

Clothing: The USATT Dress Code applies. Shorts or skirts and the main body of the shirt or blouse must be significantly different from the color of the ball (white). Tank tops, jeans, cutoffs, large designs, or large lettering will not be permitted. Socks and rubber-soled shoes must be worn. Collars and/or sleeves may be of any color. **For events with young and beginning players, and where the result will not be drastically changed, we reserve the right to relax rules (at the discretion of the Umpire presiding).**

Entry Deadline for mail-in entries to be received: Friday, April 27, 2018. There will be a \$5 fee for each phone entry and for each late entry. Players can also register online at the RITTA website: <http://www.ritta.org>

Practice: Pre-match warm up will be limited to 2 minutes.

Awards: Trophies and/or Medals will be awarded to champions.

Limitation: No player may enter more than three events.

Reporting and Starting Times: Players must check in at the desk not later than 30 minutes prior to the starting time for their earliest event.

***Note on Junior Membership** – Juniors who are members of a Rhode Island table tennis club are eligible to compete. The intent of this rule is to allow participation by those who would be qualified to participate in a Rhode Island Closed tournament per established Association rules. Junior membership would include either qualifying as a member per RITTA rules or being the child of an adult is a qualifying member.
