**“The New Jersey Regiments at Gettysburg”**  
**Saturday, April 21, 2018**

Thank you for your interest in our first annual bus tour “The New Jersey Regiments at Gettysburg” scheduled for Saturday, April 21, 2018.

Our bus tour will give you an opportunity to learn about the New Jersey regiments that were in Gettysburg during the 3 day battle on the hot days of July 1 – 3, 1863 and their positions on the battlefield during those three tumultuous days. You’ll meet living historians, walk the battlefields that Generals Robert E. Lee, George Meade, flamboyant George Pickett, Winfield Scott Hancock, James Longstreet and Lewis Armistead walked. Our guide, James Lamason, will share stories of the regiments, show you monuments raised in their honor and recommend great reading material for your further edification. At the end of the day we’ll have dinner at the Fairfield Inn, continuously operated since 1757 as a stagecoach stop, a restaurant, a bed and breakfast, a stop on the Underground Railroad and the place where General Lee stopped to eat as the Confederate Army retreated out of Pennsylvania. (His meal is one of our menu selections!) General and Mrs. Lee will be on hand during dinner to tell us about their journey through life including General Lee’s experiences in Gettysburg. Bring your questions! These living historians are very knowledgeable about the people they portray.

Our agenda for the day includes:

7:45 am – 11:00 am - Depart Milford and travel to Gettysburg via motor coach

11:00 am – 12:00 noon – Boxed lunch provided

12:00 – 1:00 pm – Visit the David Wills house where President Lincoln stayed on the eve of the dedication of the cemetery and completed his Gettysburg address

1:30 pm – 4:00 pm – Bus Tour, lecture, etc - Gettysburg Military Park

4:30 pm – Depart for the Fairfield Inn

5:00 pm – 7:00 pm – Dinner with General and Mrs. Robert E. Lee

7:30 pm – 10:30 pm – Return to Milford

Tickets are \$106 per person which includes transportation, lunch, your admission ticket for the David Wills house, the tour of the battlefield, dinner with General and Mrs. Lee, gratuity and tax. A cash bar is available at the Fairfield Inn and is not included with your ticket. Seats are limited and on a first come, first served basis.
