our home


we follow six simple rules in the nursery

learning at little keys

At Little Keys Nursery, children learn essential skills needed to become strong, confident individuals through seven areas of learning and development we call our Seven Little Keys.

Through play and adult-led activity, each child has the opportunity to explore in a nurturing, lively and engaging environment that allows them to be creative, inquisitive and to enjoy and marvel at the world around them!

personal, social and emotional development

- * Forging relationships
- * Self-confidence and self-awareness
- * Managing feelings and behaviour

Our curriculum helps children gain a sense of self-respect, independence, understanding and respect for the cultures and beliefs of others. Children learn how to form happy and rewarding relationships and develop social skills.

physical development

- * Moving and handling
- Health and self-care

Learning how to move with confidence, imagination and safety with an awareness of space, themselves and others is crucial to a child's development. We also learn about the importance of exercise, a healthy diet and personal hygiene.

communication and language



- * Listening and attention
- * Understanding
- * Speaking

Children will develop their listening and attention skills, and learn to use more words in context. We begin with simple vocabulary and build on this with phrases and sentences to help your child express their feelings and nurture their imaginations!

literacy



- * Reading
- * Writing

Children explore books and learn about individual letters; sounding out the phonics correctly before moving on to reading simple words. They will develop their writing skills using mark making activities before progressing to writing individual letters, their own names and simple words.



* Shape, space and measure

We explore shape, size and pattern, have fun doing puzzles, plaving board games and sorting and matching. Your children will begin to develop an awareness of the relationship between numbers and amounts.

understanding 6 the world



- * People and communities
- * The world
- * Technology

Children use activities, games and technology such as iPads and Bee-Bots to explore and learn about the world around us. from the natural world to different cultures.

expressive arts and design



- Exploring and using media and materials
- * Being imaginative

Children will play with a wide range of materials including crayons, paints and scissors to discover colour, texture. shape, space and form. They build their imaginations through stories, drama, dance, music and art.

At Little Keys Nursery we understand that all children respond differently to what they see, hear and experience through their senses. We provide them with lots of opportunities to explore and share their thoughts, ideas and feelings.





key information



ages

We accept children aged from two to five-years-old. We are a freeflow space and the children will be separated into areas by age groups.

opening hours

Little Keys Nursery is open for two sessions daily. You can apply for one session or both. Please note, if your child will be attending both sessions you will need to supply a packed lunch (we are a strict nut free zone).

Morning Session 9am-12pm Afternoon Session 12.30-3.30pm Full Day Session 9am-3.30pm (lunch break 12-12.30pm)

There is a signing in/out sheet at the front door which parents are required to complete daily.



timetable

A typical morning:

- * Time for the children to settle and choose their play activity
- Teacher led Learning Activities or Craftwork in small groups
- * Inside and outdoor play activities
- * Group activities including Show and Tell, story time, songs or action rhymes
- A healthy snack a plain biscuit or French bread and some fruit or raw vegetable and a drink of water

A typical afternoon:

We have weekly projects that cover a diverse range of exciting topics and you will be informed of these at least half termly. Please encourage your child to bring in something once a week that is small and relevant to the current topic.

fees

early years grant (fnep)

All three and four-year-old children are entitled to an FNEP grant the term after they have had their third birthday.

You will be required to fill in a form declaring that your child is attending the nursery for however many mornings and that you are not receiving the grant from another setting. This form is then kept onsite for inspection by auditors. We will also need to see a copy of your child's passport or birth certificate.

The grant is currently worth £5 per hour for a maximum of 15 hours per week per term, amounting to £825.

keeping you informed

We strongly believe that there is a partnership between us and you in the caring and education of your child and that there should be an ongoing exchange of information about their progress and what is happening in their lives. There's a number of ways we will commit to doing this including:

regular communications

We will send you emails to tell you about topics and special events we have coming up so you know what we are working on with the children. There is also a daily news board outside the front door on which we write every day to keep you up to date and in the know!

Our staff are always available before and after school to discuss how your child is progressing, and you are welcome to make a formal appointment at any time. Your child will also be allocated a "Key Person" who is responsible for overseeing their development and keeping their records up to date.

We host regular informal parent/ teacher sessions when we will invite you to come and talk to your child's Key Person and to show you samples of your child's work.

day book

Small changes can sometimes mean a lot to little children and it is important for us to know about them so that we can support them accordingly.

To aid this, Little Keys Nursery use a Day Book where we write down anything which you may tell us about your child that may affect them on that day. This could be, for example, that they have had a bad night and could be tired or that they are excited about their Granny picking them up that day.

bumps and bruises child protection

To comply with the National Guidelines in Safeguarding and Child protection we are required to keep a record of any injuries, bruises, cuts etc which your child has received out of nursery time.

We will keep your child safe at all times, but if any bumps do happen at the nursery, all accidents will be recorded in the Accident Book so you know exactly what happened. This will also be required to be signed by you and the witnessing staff member.

how to register your child


