



Rule-44

Team is ahead by 4 Points:

- 1)—Center Referee to inform team's coach who is ahead to change strategy
- 2)—Team that is down will add another player

After 6 Point Lead:

- 1)—Team that is ahead must kick and/or shoot outside the penalty area
- 2)—If a shot is taken within the penalty area
 - a. Ball goes into goal
 - i. Goal not allowed
 - ii. Ball is placed on the 18
 - iii. Indirect free kick (IFK)
 - b. Ball does not go into goal
 - i. Play is stopped
 - ii. Ball is placed on the 18
 - iii. Indirect free kick (IFK)
 - c. Ball goes out of bounds on goal line (no matter who touches it)
 - i. Play is stopped
 - ii. Ball is placed on the 18
 - iii. Indirect free kick (IFK)
 - d. Ball is caught by goalie—Play on
 - i. Do not stop play
- 3)—If same player(s) continue to shoot inside the penalty area
 - a. This is considered persistent infringement of the Laws of the Game (LOTG)
 - b. The player would (shall) receive a yellow card
 - c. Follow the above rules for ball placement

When lead comes down to 2 points (or Below):

- 1)—Losing team must take additional player off the field
- 2)—Winning team may begin shooting inside the penalty area
- 3)—Follow above guidelines if lead gets to 4 or 6 points

NOTE: This rule applies to Wings level and above.
