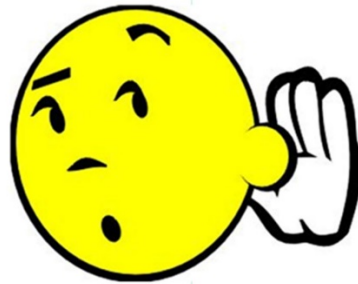


# How to Comment on the draft Neighbourhood Plan

## We want to hear from you!



After all the hard work that has been done we now need to make sure that the plan is right as it describes the vision for our villages for the ensuing 16 years and will have a lasting impact for decades beyond that.

**The 6 weeks (from Monday September 7<sup>th</sup> to Friday 19<sup>th</sup> October)** are therefore an important opportunity for you to read the plan and tell us what you think about it.

If you do not want to do this, or do not have internet access, you can use the questionnaire that came with your consultation letter and return it to one of the dedicated post boxes. These are located in Yetminster (outside the Ark, in the White Hart and inside the entrance to the Old School Gallery) and in Ryme Intrinseca and in Hamlet.
