

## **Workshop: Designing for Inclusive Community**

**November 8, 2018**

In this workshop, we'll define key design elements, housing models, and community values that support inclusive housing. First, you will be paired with a "use case," a Bay Area resident with specific housing needs and preferences. You'll work with them, and your team, to design their ideal home and community. In the afternoon, we'll take what each team designed for an individual, and think broadly about how to combine diverse individuals needs and preferences together into one inclusive city. You'll have the opportunity to share your inclusive community ideas with leading experts in transit, housing, design, and policy and explore feasibility and implementation strategies. Finally, we'll all come together to think about the ways to make our vision for inclusive communities a reality in our cities.

### **10:00-10:30: Welcome**



Kick off the day exploring our shared vision for inclusive community and hear insights from change makers leading the way in Bay Area cities.

### **10:30-12:30: Design for All**



Teams will work with use cases representing a diverse variety of Bay Area residents, and discuss their preferred housing design and type, desired amenities, services and supports, transit needs, and preferred neighborhood features and community values.

### **1:15-1:30: From the Individual to the Community**



We'll come together for group discussion about how to take what we learned from individual use case discussions to generate broader ideas for designing an inclusive city that factors in a variety of needs and preferences.

### **1:30-3:00: Designing an Inclusive City**



Factoring in the diversity of use cases from the morning activity, you will work with other workshop participants to design an inclusive city, focusing on things like anchor institutions, amenities, transit, cultural values and norms, and look and feel. What elements make a great city and how do you make those elements inclusive of people of all ages, abilities, and backgrounds?

Share your inclusive community ideas with leaders in transit, housing, and design and discuss feasibility, implementation, and best-practices.

Close the workshop with an interactive discussion of next steps and how to make what we've envisioned in our workshop a reality in our communities.
