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**Job Description:**

This role is suited to students aged 16-18 interested in any type of potential career working with children, in particular careers in education, childcare, medical, social work or youth work.

Students are offered **one** week of work experience during the five weeks of Camp Yolo. You are required to complete an application form and indicate which week or weeks you are available to attend Camp Yolo. You will be paid £50 to cover all expenses, payable by BACS on completion of a full week of attendance. Your work experience can provide you with valuable skills and experience for your personal statement for UCAS application, job applications and future careers.

Duties & Responsibilities

You will have the opportunity to spend a week working with young children as part of a team expertly qualified in the education sector. Your role will be to ensure that children enjoy their time at Camp Yolo, that they are encouraged to participate fully in all activities, that they are safe and learn something new, meet new friends and take part in new activities during their time in Camp.

Key duties & responsibilities will include:

- Engage in guided and directed activities with children
- Get to know the children that you are working with
- Assist with registration, ensure all reporting is completed as appropriate.
- Be proactive in encouraging positive behaviour in children and learn how to manage challenging behaviour.
- Take part in activities by working and supporting children, facilitators and leaders
- Assist with supervision of children throughout each day
- You may have the opportunity to plan and deliver any activity
- You will receive mentoring from senior staff.
- You will have the opportunity to engage with parents and children at drop off / pick up
- Learn about the daily administrative requirement of running a camp.
